#### Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Arfan Ahmad Butt, Proponent/Manager Legal,  
M/s the Crescent Textile Mills Ltd, Plot No.  
48-49, Phase-III, Industrial Estate Hattar, District  
Haripur.
2. **Description of project:** The said project is the extension of the existing  
unit of Crescent Textile Mills on the plot No. 48-  
49, Phase-III, Industrial Estate Hattar District  
Haripur. Total Capacity of the unit is 1.5 Million  
Meter/ Month. The construction and operational  
phase of the project will require power (3MW)  
which will be supplied by Water and Power  
Development Authority (WAPDA)/Standby  
generator. About 25-30 labor and technicians will  
work during construction phase, whereas 60-70  
Staff will work for the operation of the project.
3. **Location of the project:** Plot No. 48-49, Phase-III, Industrial Estate Hattar,  
District Haripur.

5. After careful review of IEE report and field visit report carried out by officers of this  
Agency on 06/01/2022, the Environmental Protection Agency, Northern Directorate,  
Abbottabad, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial  
Environmental Examination of **Extension of Weaving Unit of M/S The Crescent  
Textile Mills Limited** at Plot No. 48-49, Phase-III, Industrial Estate Hattar, District  
Haripur of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and  
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules 2021 subject to the following  
terms & conditions:
  - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE  
report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase  
of project.



- b) The proponent shall ensure compliance with the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
  - c) Waste water treatment plant must be installed as mentioned in the IIE report for the compliance of NEQS.
  - d) In case of installation of standby generator, sound proof techniques should be adopted
  - e) The construction material shall be stored in such a way that it should not destroy or damage environment.
  - f) Water sprinkling should be carried out on daily basis during construction activities as dust suppressant.
  - g) Effective arrangements shall be made for the proper disposal of solid waste. The solid waste shall be retained within the unit boundary/premises and will be disposed of in an environment friendly way at a suitable disposal facility.
  - h) Health & Safety equipments (mask, helmet, glasses, gloves, shoes, air plugs, etc) should be provided to the workers.
  - i) The proponent shall plant 500 native trees/plants according to the tree plantation plan provided by the proponent i.e. 100 trees each year.
  - j) CSR activities carried out should be shared with this Agency on regular basis.
  - k) Fire extinguishers, first aid box etc shall be installed inside the factory in case any emergency.
  - l) Employment shall be provided to the locals in the field of technical (If available) and non technical cadre.
  - m) Health and safety sign boards/posters shall be installed in various places within the plant.
  - n) The proponent shall submit monthly monitoring report to this Agency for effluents and emissions according to NEQS Smart Rules 2001.
6. The proponent shall be liable for replacement/upgradation of the waste water treatment plant, if the treatment plant failed to bring the effluents within National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
7. Environmental Management Plan must be strictly followed.
8. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.


