2. Description of Project:

The proponent has intended to install NKB asphalt plant near Nagoha Bridge, Tehsil Barikot, District Swat on the temporary basis for the production of asphalt to fulfil the requirements of different project. The production capacity of the plant will be 40 ton/ hour. Total area 16 kanal land has been acquired on the lease basis. Total cost of the project is four (04) Crore Rupees.

3. Location of project:

The project is located at District Swat.

5. After a careful review and field visit carried out by Mr. Adil Jan Monitoring Inspector, EPA Regional Office Swat. The Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) for " NKB Asphalt Plant near Nagoha Bridge, Tehsil Barikot, District Swat Khyber Pakhtunkhwa," in line with the guidelines issued under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 subject to the following terms & conditions:

- The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE Report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of the project.
 - All the construction and installation in the project area must be carried out according to the detail given in the IEE report.
 - The proponent is bounded to submit finalized layout plan before commencement of construction on the project site.
 - The Proponent must install scrubber/showering and filters to control the odour & air emission of the project.
 - The premises must be kept clean at all times with good housekeeping, a well design sprinkling system must be installed to prevent the dust pollution.


- f) Boundary wall must be constructed around the project area for protection of the river/agricultural field/ road etc
- g) Noise generating equipment such as generators, compressors must be provided with appropriate Noise attenuating material/ structures.
- h) Precautionary measures must be taken for safe haulage of the materials such that there is no spill over during transportation on the road/ Road network.
- i) Proper Parking facility must be provided within the project area for loading and unloading vehicles.
- j) Contaminated soil and water must be treated properly through incineration/ oil separator.
- k) The proponent is bounded to submit air analysis report of the project on annual basis in order to check/monitor the working capacity of the scrubber and air filters.
- l) The proponent shall keep the record cleaning of the settlings tanks and intimate this Agency on regular basis.
- m) The Proponent shall provide Personal Protection Equipments (PPEs) to the workers of the unit and will ensure the use of Personal Protection Equipments during working hours.
- n) Total 20 plants/trees of local species shall be planted along the boundary wall and available spaces within the project area.
- o) A sign board must be displayed near the gate side/ entrance route for general information to the public regarding name of the project, name of the Proponent, Contact number of the proponent, name of in-charge of the unit and his contact number etc.
- p) Precautionary sign boards and Environmental messages must be mounted at appropriate sites for awareness of workers/ visitors.
- q) The proponent shall provide the copy of this approval and IEE report to the contractor for information and compliance.
- r) Settling tanks must be constructed to collect the waste water from the unit and after proper treatment; it may be reused in the project activities such as sprinkling without any discharging into the surrounding environment.
- s) Solid waste of the project must be collected and disposed of at the properly designated dumping site.
- t) The proponent shall provide non-technical jobs to the surrounding villagers of the project.
- u) All the emissions/effluents (if any) shall be kept within permissible limits of National Environmental Quality standards (NEQS).

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- v) EPA monitoring team will regularly visit the project site and suggest further measures for the improvement of environment.
- w) The proponent shall be responsible to facilitate the EPA team during visit/inspection/monitoring.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided by the Environmental Consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rules 10,13,14,15, 19 and 20 of Environmental Assessment Rules 2021, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project.
 9. The proponent will obtain approval for operation phase as well as renewal of the operation approval after every three years of the project in accordance with the Rules 13 (2) (b), 15 (4) and 20 of the Environmental Assessment Rules 2021.
 10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 13. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 14. In exercise of the power under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
