2. **Description of project:** The proponent has intended to install Al-Kareem CNG Filling Station at Gul Abad, Tehsil Barikot District Swat. The storage capacity of the CNG Filling Station is 3200 liters and total area of the project is 11937.5 sq.ft. Total cost of the project is 25 Million


5. After a field visit carried out by Mr. Sadiq Ullah Khan, Monitoring Inspector, EPA (Malakand) Regional office Swat. The Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional construction Environmental approval on the General Environmental Approval guideline for "Al-Kareem CNG Filling Station at Gulabad, Tehsil Barikot, District Swat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa," in line with the guidelines issued under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in GEA guidelines as well as any unanticipated impacts during construction phase of the project.
 - b) All the construction and installation in the project area shall be carried out according to master plan.
 - c) The safety measures as specified in petroleum Rules shall be implemented within the premises of the project area.
 - d) Personal Protective Equipments must be provided to all workers during the working hours.
 - e) Precautionary sign board and Environmental messages must be mounted at appropriate sites
 - f) Entry in to and exit rout from the CNG Filling station shall be metallic and must not hamper the traffic movement in front of the station.
 - g) A proper drainage system shall be provided from the CNG Filling Station and used lube oil in the jet wash shall be properly disposed of /recycled.
 - h) Washrooms will be constructed at the CNG Filling station; one washroom must be allocated for Female use



- i) All the washrooms must be cleaned on daily basis.
 - j) Prayer place/ Mosque must be constructed in the project area.
 - k) Service station is not allowed within the premises of CNG Filling Station.
 - l) Plantation of 20 plants must be carried out within the premises of the CNG Filling Station and shall take-care of the same.
 - m) Grasses and vegetation around the storage tank is potential source of Ignition. It shall be cleared and the area shall be concreted or tiled.
 - n) Solid waste of the project must be collected on daily basis and properly dispose of at the TMA dumping site.
 - o) Noise generating equipment such as generators, compressors must be provided with appropriate Noise attenuating material/ structures.
 - p) The proponent shall provide non-technical jobs to the local community of the project.
 - q) All the emissions/effluents (if any) shall be kept within permissible limits of National Environmental Quality standards (NEQS).
 - r) EPA monitoring team will regularly visit the project site and suggest further measures for the improvement of environment.
 - s) The proponent shall be responsible to facilitate the EPA team during visit/inspection/monitoring.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided by the Environmental Consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rules 10,13,14,15, 19 and 20 of Environmental Assessment Rules 2021, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project.
 9. The proponent will obtain approval for operation phase as well as renewal of the operation approval after every three years of the project in accordance with the Rules 13 (2) (b), 15 (4) and 20 of the Environmental Assessment Rules 2021.
 10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 13. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 14. In exercise of the power under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the GEA Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
