### Decision on IEE

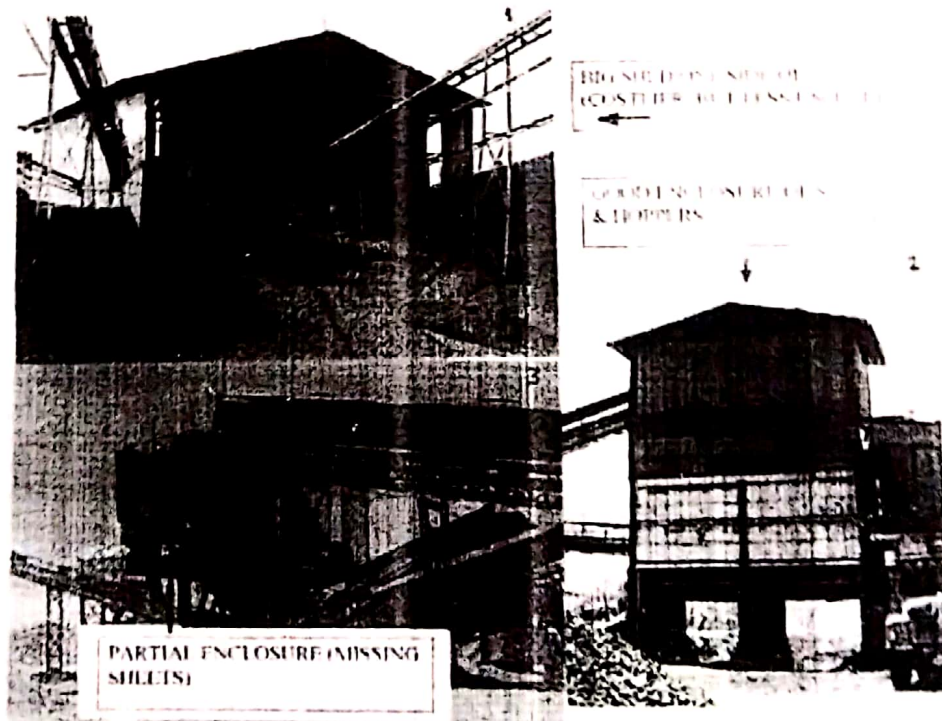

- Description of project:** the proposed project is located 2km away  
from Muree road and lies near to Takia road  
near Dhamtor in village Tara. The total area of  
land is approx, 4000 kanals, in which approx.  
02 kanal will be required for installation of  
stone crushing plant. Bored water will be  
established along with rain water harvested  
through water tank and will be utilized during  
construction and operation phase. The total  
water consumption during operational phase  
will be 55-60m<sup>3</sup> /day. Power will be supplied  
during construction and operational phase by  
WAPDA.. Environmental Management Plan  
(EMP) is prepared to minimize the anticipated  
impact of the proposed project on the  
surrounding Environment.

- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- b) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- c) The distance shall be implemented by Industry department as per provision of Rule 3 of Powers Crushers (Installation, Operation and Registration) 1998 (amended)".
- d) Carry sprays twice a day i.e 7:00 am and 1:00 pm on non metal roads during construction and operation phase in order to minimize dust during delivery.
- e) The proponent should cover the delivery vehicles properly.
- f) Health Safety equipments (mask, helmet, glasses, gloves, shoes, air plugs, etc) should be provided to the workers.
- g) Plantation of 100 No of well established plants of Chinar, 100 No of walnuts plants must be planted in the month of July & August 2018 on the boundary of water channel in the area.
- h) The water channel must be kept clean and tidy from any kind of debris and encroachment.
- i) Water spray should be carried out on material through a water pump connected with pipelines and water spraying nozzles.
- j) The proponent will install Air/Dust Control System as per SOPs of stone crush plant: Specification and drawing of Dust/Air Pollution Control System is given as below):



6. The proponent shall be liable for replacement/up gradation of the Air/Dust






- bring the dust emission within National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS), until and unless to bring the dust emission level within National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
7. Environmental Management Plan must be strictly followed.
  8. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
  9. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 11, 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, written confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring.
  10. This approval is accorded only for the "CONSTRUCTION PHASE" of project.
  11. The proponent will obtain approval for "OPERATION OF THE PROJECT" in accordance with the section 13 (2) (b) and section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
  12. The proponent will obtain a separate NOC for "MINING ACTIVITIES" from this Agency.
  13. The installation site of the crush plant must be 300 meters away from the human settlement.
  14. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Northern Directorate, Abbottabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
  15. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
  16. There is no legal pending in the courts against the project.
  17. In exercise of the power under Section 14 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and The Delegation of Powers Vide letter No. EPA/050/01/93/ Peshawar, dated the may 19, 2017, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for Ayub Khan Stone Crush plant with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
  18. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
