Decision on IEE

1. Name, address of proponent: Mr. Ataullah Shah & Khan Bahadar,
Owner of Falak Sair Dyeing Unit,
Near GT Road, Kabal, District Swat

2. Description of project. The Falaksair Dyeing Mills is a textile dyeing industry which will be constructed on Shamozai Road in District Swat, Northern area of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province. The site is located behind a petrol pump named Askar Petrol Pump. The site is almost 50 meters away from the Highway. The total occupied area of the factory will be 16 Canals (approx). The Site is surrounded by different kind of fields specially that of Peach fruit and trees of Popular Ciliata (Sufeda). The river swat is about 2.5 km away from the proposed site.

3. Location of project. The proposed project is located in Akund Kalaly, Tehsil Kabal, District swat.



5. After careful review of the Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) report of project "Falak Sair Dyeing Unit" followed by queries, comments, clarifications / replies by the proponent and submission of agreement with Baig textile Mills Pvt. Limited regarding training of labors/ and provision of land documents from the owner / proponent and visit report of Assistant Director EPA-Regional office Swat, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Regional Office Swat Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord its approval with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/ EIA Regulations, 2000 on IEE report subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the IEE report as well as replies of the proponent submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the construction and operation phase of the project.
 - b) The proponent shall not discharge untreated waste water into the surface water body
 - c) The proponent shall construct a slow sand filtration plant/ treatment facility to bring the effluent within the NEQS permissible limit.
 - d) The proponent shall be bound to control its emission/effluents if any, not exceeding the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
 - e) The proponent shall carry out plantation of at least 500 local species (trees) in and around the boundary and available space in the factory. Plantation plan shall be submitted to this agency.
 - f) The proponent shall carry out training programs for labors and intimate this Agency regarding training programs conducted at regular basis.

- g) The proponent shall pave the access road present in the front of the proposed unit to avoid dust pollution.
 - h) Non technical jobs shall be provided to the local community, and if suitable candidate for technical job is available in the area preference shall be given to them.
 - i) Water sprinkling shall be carried out on regular basis during construction phase for control of dust pollution in the area.
 - j) Health and safety equipments must be provided to the workers during working hours.
 - k) The proponent shall ensure a designated place for solid waste and the same shall be dispose-off as per solid waste management system.
 - l) Proper mitigation measures shall be adopted to control bad/pungent smell.
 - m) The proponent shall ensure space for car parking in factory premises.
 - n) Sign boards must be installed on the sensitive areas for guidance of the workers as well as visitors.
 - o) Security must be provided and fire extinguishers must be installed at appropriate points.
 - p) Any other measures as suggested by this Agency must be followed during construction/operation stage..
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, validity period of approval, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 7. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the construction and development phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for functional of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 12. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
