2. **Description of project:** The project is to establish oil reclamation
plant at Plot No, 62, Road 3, Phase III,
Hattar Industrial Estate, District Haripur.
Total area of the plot is 05 Kanals. Typically
lubricating oil product essentially contains
90% base oil and 10% additives. The raw
material is used engine oil being
transported through tankers.
3. **Location of the project:** The proposed project is located at Plot No,
62, Road 3, Phase III, Hattar Industrial
Estate, District Haripur
4. **Date of filling of IEE:** **13-02-2019**
EPA, Northern Directorate (Dairy No.4089)
5. After careful review of IEE report, the Environmental Protection Agency,
Northern Directorate, Abbottabad, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided
to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination of Rehmat
Lubricant, Plot NO 62, Phase III, Hattar Industrial Estate, District Haripur of
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and
IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:
 - a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures
identified in the IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during
the construction and operational phase of the project.
 - b) The non-technical/technical jobs must be provided to the local people
of the area.



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- (c) Personal Protective equipments must be provided to all workers to ensure health and health and safety with first aid box for emergency medical coverage.
 - (d) The plantation must be carried out as per recommendation in the IEE report.
 - (e) Environment related message should be mounted in and outside of the storage.
 - (f) Sign Board must be installed on the sensitive areas for guidance of the workers as well as visitors.
 - (g) Security must be provided and fire extinguishers must be installed at appropriate points.
 - (h) The site is not under litigation in any court of law.
 - (i) Rest room / wash room shall be provided at the unit.
 - (j) Mitigation measures must be adopted to control leakages during process.
 - (k) Fresh water must be recycled and must not discharge outside from the unit.
 - (l) Solid waste generated during the process shall be disposed off properly.
 - (m) Proper training shall be carried out for handling and operating the machinery.
 - (n) Solid waste (used Bleach) must be properly disposed off.
 - (o) Waste from the process must be kept covered space till the final disposal.
 - (p) The unit must comply with the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS)
6. Environmental Management Plan must be strictly followed.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 11, 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, written confirmation of compliance, entry, Inspection and monitoring.
 9. This approval is accorded only for the "CONSTRUCTION PHASE" of project.
 10. The proponent will obtain approval for "OPERATION OF THE PROJECT" in accordance with the section 13 (2) (b) and section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 11. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Northern Directorate, Abbottabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.



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
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12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.

Sub: **OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVAL**

Kindly refer to application dated 11-08-2020 on the subject cited above & in light of Environmental Protection Tribunal (EPT) judgement dated 12-03-2020 and to state that this Agency allows operation of Rehmat Lubricants (Oil Reclamation Plant), Phase-IV, Street No. 03, Hattar Industrial Estate, District Haripur with the following mitigations for Environment Protection & Improvement;

1. The management shall comply with the conditions of the construction phase environmental approval.
2. All the mitigation measures identified in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) of the IEE Report shall be adopted.
3. Pollution Control System shall be used & maintained for the control of air emissions as well as effluents during operation of the unit.
4. All the emissions (Air, Water) shall be kept within the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
5. Effluents (if any) shall not be discharge outside without treatment. The effluents shall comply with the NEQS.
6. The management shall carry out & submit to this Agency quarterly analysis report of the stack & effluent emissions by EPA certified Lab.
7. Latest Fire Extinguishing System shall be installed in the unit.
8. Proper mitigation measures shall be adopted for the leakages and during addition of the acid. Moreover, mitigation measures shall be adopted for the acid fumes.
9. Plantation shall be carried out inside & along with the boundary wall of the unit.
10. Personal Protective Equipment's (PPEs) shall be provided to the workers & ensure its usage during working hours.
11. This Agency, whenever required, shall suggest further mitigations for environment protection & improvement.
12. In case of extension/design changes, prior approval shall be obtained from this Agency.

You are, therefore directed to comply with above mentioned conditions/mitigation measures. In case of non-compliance, this Agency reserve the right to cancel the operational Environmental Approval at any stage & Initiate action against you as per the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, please.
