1. **Name, address of proponent:** Abdul Ghafoor,
Deputy Director-II,
Foreign Aided Projects,
Works and Services
Department,
House#129, Shami road,
Peshawar cantt.
2. **Description of project.** The subproject is for
Reconstruction and
improvement of existing
road. The existing road will
be improved to pave width of
3.65 m with 2 meter wide
earthen shoulders on both
sides. The road start from
Mohal at the main Mardan By
Pass up to village Koragh
having a length of 3.00 km
where as the Ibrahim Khan
Kally road has the length of
0.8 km and take up point is
on Charsadda road and
terminates at Ibrahim Khan
Kally.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in
District Mardan.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 28/05/2009
Ref (EPA, Diary No. 1930)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt.
of NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Initial
Environmental Examination for Reconstruction and improvement
of LCB-61 Road from Mohal Loragh & Ibrahim Khan Kally road in
District Mardan ADB Loan No.2103-Pak (OCR) in line with the
guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000
subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory
measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-
anticipated impacts during the construction and operation
phase of project.

- b) The debris should be properly disposed off.
 - c) The proponent should provide copy of land agreement made with property owner if land acquisition is involved.
 - d) Submission certification for restoration of site after completion of the activity.
 - e) Site camp will be located away from the residential area.
 - f) There should be proper and regular sprinkling of water for the control of dust pollution.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, NWFP and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
