2. **Description of project:** The project is proposed to establish at Plot # 09-24, B-2, B-3 & B-4, Zone B, Hattar Economic Zone, District Haripur. The total area of the project is 16 Acre and 06 Kanals. The proposed project is the establishment of ASU plant for manufacturing of medical and industrial Gases and Gases filling unit. The product includes Liquid Oxygen, Liquid Nitrogen and Liquid Argon. The machinery will include the air compressor, storage tanks, filling point's cylinder filing racks filing points.
3. **Location of the project:** The project is located Plot # 09-24, B-2, B-3 & B-4, Zone B, Hattar Economic Zone, District Haripur.

5. After careful review of IEE report and field visit report carried out by official of this Agency on 24-06-2021, the Environmental Protection Agency, Northern Directorate, Abbottabad, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination of Ghani Chemical, Hattar Economic Zone, District Haripur of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:



- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
  - b) The mitigation measures suggested in the IEE report and Environmental management plan shall be strictly followed.
  - c) Employment should be provided to local people particularly for unskilled jobs.
  - d) Monitoring shall be carried out during the entire period of the project activities. Monitoring reports shall be submitted to EPA North office quarterly.
  - e) The proponent shall plant 500 no of plant i.e (Chinar, Walnut and fruit plants) in the project site area.
  - f) Health Safety equipment (mask, helmet, glasses, gloves, shoes, air plugs, etc) should be provided to the workers.
  - g) The proponent shall install proper waste water treatment facility to make the waste water as per NEQS.
  - N (h) The proponent shall provide proper firefighting arrangement in the factory.
  - (j) The proponent shall install the state of art machinery which is latest in its development cycle.
  - (k) The proponent shall take effective measures for safe storage and transportation of gases.
6. Environmental Management Plan must be strictly followed
  7. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
  8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 11, 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, written confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring.
  9. This approval is accorded only for the "CONSTRUCTION PHASE" of project.
  10. The proponent will obtain separate approval for "OPERATION OF THE PROJECT" in accordance with the section 13 (2) (b) and section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.




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11. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Northern Directorate, Abbottabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
13. There is no legal pending in the courts against the project.
14. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
15. In exercise of the power under Section 14 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and The Delegation of Powers Vide letter No. EPA/050/01/93/ Peshawar, dated the May 19, 2017, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for Ghani Chemicals with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
16. This approval shall be valid (for commencement of construction) for the period of three years from the date of issue under regulation 17 of IEE/EIA Regulation, 2000.
