- 2. Description of project.** The Swat Seed and Farm Services Pvt.
Ltd. "AgroChem" is proposed to
manufacture and distribution of
pesticides, herbicides and liquid and
solid plants nutrients/Fertilizers. The
total capacity of plant is 10-20
tons/day. The estimated cost of the
project is 3 million.
- 3. Location of project.** The project is located at Spalmai near
Gaman bridge at District Swat.
- 4. Date of filing of EIA.** 07-08-2014
(Ref. EPA Diary No. 253)
- 5.** After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact
Assessment report for the Agro Chem, District Swat, in line with the
guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the
following terms & conditions:-
- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures
identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the
construction and operation phases of project.
 - b) Non technical jobs must be provided to the local community.
 - c) Plantation plan along with number of species and plants must be
provided to this Agency before starting physical activities.
 - d) Health and safety measures through personal protection equipments
should be provided to the staff during construction and operation stage.
 - e) Sign boards must be installed on which the names of all the chemicals
and precaution measures are being written.
 - f) Chemicals must be kept in a safe place where signboards must be
installed.

- g) Copy of agreement regarding number/name of chemical and quantity from where these are purchased.
- h) Empty chemical's containers/bags/bottles and expired chemicals must not be thrown outside the boundary wall of the unit.
- i) Waste water/effluents if any must not be discharged outside the premises of the unit.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of Agro Chem with above mentioned terms and conditions.
