2. **Description of project.** M/S BSF Steel Rerolling Mill &
Furnace is located at Plot 151-A,
Hayatabad Industrial Estate, District
Peshawar with estimated production
capacity of 6 ton/hour and total cost
of the project will be 200.00
million rupees including the cost
of construction, machinery and
other equipments and will be
completed within 06 months. The
total covered area of the project is
1.73 Acre. The total height of the
steel hall structure will be 52 feet
while the cranes will be installed at
42 feet. The major solid waste
generated from a steel melting unit
will be not toxic waste and will be
reused. The ground water will be
extracted for production purposes.
Electric power will be required during
construction and operation phase
which will be provided by the PESCO/
WAPDA.
The project is located in Hayatabad
Industrial Estate, District Peshawar.

5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Government of
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval on the
Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report of **M/S BSF Steel
Rerolling Mill & Furnace is located at Plot 151-A, Hayatabad
Industrial Estate, District Peshawar** according to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa
Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000,
subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the EIA Report as well as replies of the proponent submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the construction and operation phase of the project.
 - b) Effluents and emissions from the mill as well as from the generators shall be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
 - c) The proponent shall submit quarterly compliance report of the conditions of Environmental Approval.
 - d) Certification of VETS for vehicular emission control shall be submitted to this Agency.
 - e) Employment shall be provided to the locals in the field of technical (if available) and non technical cadre.
 - f) Personal Protective Equipments (PPEs) like Masks, Fire Proof Jackets, Gloves, Goggles, Helmets, etc. must be provided to the workers during the working hours.
 - g) CCTV cameras shall be installed at the effluents/emission sites and online access shall be provided to the CCTV Cameras recordings to EPA KPK officials to ensure round the clock monitoring of Pollution Control Technology.
 - h) Health and Safety Equipments like fire extinguishers, first aid box, sign boards, etc. shall be installed/maintained inside the Unit.
 - i) The details of CSR activities shall be shared with this Agency on yearly basis.
 - j) Plantation of 50 trees shall be carried out in the available open spaces of the proposed project unit as per submitted plan.
 - k) High grade billets/metal shall be used for melting.
 - l) Natural Gas (Sui Gas) shall be used as fuel for Heating/melting purposes.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain separate approval for operation of the project in



accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.

9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void, if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with:
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project
