Description of project.

M/S Bestway Cement Limited (BCL) intends To establish a new cement plant (Production line-II) at 12 Km, Taxila Haripur road, Farooqia district Haripur. The raw material are available in close vicinity and has utilization of 3700 tons per day by the existing line of Farooqia BCL and the reserves are good enough to serve a 6000 tons plant over a 100 year. The proposed cement plant will operate 24 hours a day and will acquire power from WAPDA through a 132 KV transmission line passing nearby, it will consume 1000 tones of imported coal per day. The proposed project will require 650 personal for its plant and mine operation.

3. Location of project.

The Project site is located in District Haripur.

5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment EIA Report for "Best Way Cement Limited, New Cement Plant (Production line-II), Taxila Haripur road, Farooqia District Haripur, in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- b) All emissions shall be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- c) The proponent shall be bound to install Air Pollution Control System (Bag House Filter) to bring its emission in compliance with National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
- d) Maintenance of the Bag House Filter shall be carried out regularly and the report shall be submitted to this Agency.
- e) Agreement for stack analysis with 3<sup>rd</sup> party shall be made and details shall be provided to this Agency.

- Waste shall be properly dumped in designated area within the premises of  
Treatment Plant.
- Health and Safety Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to the staff and detail of  
the same should be provided to this Agency.
- Signboards regarding health and safety shall be installed at the unit.
- Tree Plantation shall be carried out in the open spaces and around the Boundary  
Wall. The Plan and sites for plantation shall be provided to this Agency.
- parking, loading and unloading area shall be provided to facilitate the vehicles.
- k) Existing Right of Way (ROW) should not be blocked/disturbed from the proposed  
activity.
- l) Employment shall be provided to the local people of the nearest Union Councils in  
technical/non technical jobs.
- m) Special quota shall be allocated for the locals during recruitment of the trainees  
and apprenticeship.
- n) Social welfare programs shall be carried out for the local people and share with  
this Agency.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied  
by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 11,13,14,17 and 18 of  
IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry,  
inspections and monitoring.
8. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with  
the Regulations 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber  
Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions  
mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other  
approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Regulations 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa,  
Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA  
Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and  
conditions.
