1. **Name, address of proponent:** Director (Environment),

2. **Description of project.** National Highway Authorities (NHA) has planned Rehabilitation of Chitral-Ayun-Bomborate Road which is 48KM in length approximately. Presently under this project the road is divided into four portions. Basically this section of road is in three different directions and approximately the road has following sections.

3. **Location of Project:** The project site is located at District Chitral.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 12-10-2017 Ref. (EPA Diary No. 377)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval to the Environmental Impact Assessment of "Construction Of Chitral-Ayun-Bumborate Road (48 Km), District Chitral Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
- The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA Report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
  - Land ownership documents/acquisition/lease agreements duly verified shall be provided to EPA before commencement of construction activities.
  - All conflicting issues regarding compensation, lease agreement etc if any to be settled down before executing or commencing of the project activities and a certificate in this regard should be submitted to EPA.
  - Tree Plantation/Compensation plan shall be provided to this Agency before the physical work is started on the site.
  - Site for batching plant shall be located at least 500 meters away from the residential area.

...sprinkling of water for the control of dust pollution during the construction process shall be maintained.

- g) A copy of the agreement made with the contractor for the mitigation measures/control of environmental/ social problems during construction process shall be provided.
  - h) Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the local people in the area.
  - i) Debris/ cutting materials of the road shall be disposed off in a proper dumping site and details of the same should be provided to this agency.
  - j) Traffic rules shall be strictly followed for Traffic Management Plan and proper signboards shall be installed to avoid any inconvenience in the existing Right of Way (RoW).
  - k) The proponent shall ensure strict and efficient safety measures for the protection of workers and passersby.
  - l) Personal Protective Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to the workers during working hours.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
  7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
  8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulation 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
  9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
  10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
  11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
  12. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Environmental Protection Act, 2014 the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of the said project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
