### Decision on EIA

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Brig. (R) Abdul Samad Khan,

2. **Description of project.** The Proposed Mill site is located  
at Hayatabad Industrial Estate.  
The Consumer Line Steel Re-Rolling  
Mill aim at preparing steel bar for  
construction. Manufacturing of steel bar  
requires billets and ingots as the major  
raw material. The consumption of billets  
and ingots will be about 100 tons per  
day and is recycled inside the plant. The  
natural gas will used as a fuel.
3. **Location of project.** Consumer Line Steel Re-Rolling  
Mill, Plot No.102, Hayatabad Industrial  
Estate, Peshawar.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 05/05/2010  
(Ref: EPA/Dairy No.133)
5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber  
Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord Conditional approval of the Environmental  
Impact Assessment for Consumer Line Steel Re-Rolling Mill, Hayatabad  
Industrial Estate Peshawar, in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and  
IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
  - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified  
in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and  
operation phase of project.
  - b) The proponent must submit monthly compliance report.
  - c) Employment should be provided to local people particularly for non-  
technical jobs.
  - d) The solid waste should be disposed off in land fill area or hand over  
to Municipal Committee.
  - e) Tree plantation should be carried out around the boundary wall and in  
front/open area.
  - f) Emissions and effluents if any should be kept within the permissible limit of  
National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
  - g) Oil and scum skimmer should be installed to remove the oil and grease traces  
from the waste water.

- h) A-one-piece suit, manufactured from light weight aluminized fire-resistant material designed for use as close proximity, fire fight suit and for protection of intense heat & severe flame should be provided to the workers. (copy of the model is enclosed)
- i) Recycling of usable water should be ensured and there should be no discharge of waste water out side the factory.
- j) Workers should be protected from the noise by providing ear defenders on a safety helmet.(copy of the model is enclosed)
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for Consumer Line Steel Re-Rolling Mill with above mentioned terms and conditions.
