2. **Description of project.** MU Plastic proposes the establishment of plant for production of High Density Poly Ethylene (HDPE) with a capacity of 25 M/Ton per month at Plot No 19-B, Hayatabad Industrial Estate, Peshawar. Total Cost of the project is Rs. 2.2 Million and will create employment for 8-10 people.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Peshawar.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 20-03-2017 (Ref. EPA Diary No. 1527)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment report for the "HDPE Pipe Industry, Hayatabad Industrial Estate, District Peshawar", in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
- The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phases of project.
 - Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the local community.
 - The waste water/recycle water must be collected in the underground storage tanks after passing through machines and do not discharge directly to outside of the unit.
 - Personal Protective Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to the staff during construction and operation stage.
 - Sign boards regarding Health Safety shall be installed in the sensitive area for the awareness of staff.
 - Cooling jacket, chiller and overhead reservoir shall be incorporated in the final design.
 - Detail of raw material storage, fire safety etc shall be provided to this Agency before the approval, as the raw material is highly inflammable.

- Effluent shall be kept in accordance with NEQs and the same shall be discharged to sewerage line after proper treatment.
6. j) Solid Waste should be properly dumped in designated area.
- k) Tree plantation shall be carried out in the premises/around the boundary wall and in front of the factory. At least 100 evergreen plants shall be planted.
7. The proposed monitoring program in the EIA report shall be strictly implemented. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant in the EIA Report/replies to the queries of this Agency.
8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
9. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the unit. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulations 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
13. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
14. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report with above mentioned terms and conditions.
