### Decision on EIA

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Managing Director/CEO,  
MOL Pakistan Oil & Gas Co.  
B.V. Plot No. 5/A, Crown Plaza, F-7  
Markaz, Islamabad. P.O Box. 1562.
2. **Description of project.** MOL Pakistan Oil and Gas Company intended drilling of Mammi khel deep-01 Well and construction of associated well head surface/flow line facilities in its Tal Block located at Kohat Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The project area is located at Gurzandi game reserve at a distance of 7.1km from Tehsil Lachi and adjacent to Dar Malik Ali Kach game reserve. Mammi khel deep-01 Well will be connected through flow line to Mammikhel-2 tie in point to pipeline network of MOL Pakistan in the area with expected length of 350-400 meters.
3. **Location of project.** The proposed project is located in District Kohat.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 06-12-2016  
(Ref: EPA/Diary No. 128)
5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment EIA Report of Mammi Khel Deep-01 Well, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
  - a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.

- a) The area for the proposed activity located in proximity of Ghurzandi game reserve, strict mitigation measures shall be adopted to lessen the impacts on Wildlife of the area.
- c) The crew members shall be imparted with Wildlife awareness trainings prior to commencing any work activities in the protected area.
- d) Illegal hunting shall not be allowed
- e) To prevent disturbance to migratory faunal species, project activities shall be completed in shortest time as possible.
- f) Breeding centre for the bird species shall be introduced in the game reserve, as this will help to extend the population of the birds.
- g) Activities shall be planned in such a way that breeding season of the key species of the area is not affected.
- h) The proponent shall provide copy of agreement between MOL Pakistan and the local people of the area regarding land/crop compensation along with their complete addresses to this Agency.
- i) The project area shall not come in the sensitive area.
- j) The proponent of the project shall ensure to provide safety equipments to the staff like rubber shoes/boots, gloves, glasses, overall and ear plugs etc.
- k) Sprinkling of water on the road shall be carried out on regularly basis.
- l) Existing road facility shall be maintained properly.
- m) Plantation plan shall be provided before starting the physical activities and the same shall be to this Agency.
- n) Social Life (e.g Parada) of the area shall be protected.
- o) Non-Technical jobs shall be provided to the local people of the area and priority should also be given to technical jobs.
- p) The affected area shall be restored/rehabilitated in the original form after the completion of drilling activity.
- q) Oil-based-mud shall be sent to MOL Bioremediation facility located in Gurguri, District Karak for final disposal.
- r) The proponent shall be bound to control its emission/effluents if any not exceeding the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).

The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied in the Report.

7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for Mammi Khel Deep-01 Well, District Kohat with above mentioned terms and conditions.
