5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment of M/S Frontier Foundry Steel (Pvt) Ltd at Plot No 166, Industrial Estate Hayatabad, Jamrud Road, District Peshawar, of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in EIA report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
 - b) The proponent shall submit monthly compliance-report,
 - c) All scrap metal shall be cleaned before the induction process in the furnace. Only high grade scrap metal shall be used.
 - d) The proponent shall be bound to install air pollution control system (Dry System) to bring its emission in compliance with National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).

- e) Employment shall be provided to the local people in technical/non technical jobs.
- f) Health and safety equipments shall be provided to the workers during working hours.
- g) Plantation shall be carried out in the available open spaces of the proposed project area and the plan of the same shall be provided to this Agency.
- h) Effluents and emissions shall be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulation 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000. The proponent shall inform this agency when construction phase is completed.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report with above mentioned terms and conditions.
