- 2. Description of project.** The proposed site for the Marble city Risalpur is located closed to the motorway Peshawar (M-2) from the north and from the eastern side linked with Nowshera Mardan Road. It will be established at the area of 185 acres. The estimated cost is 420 million. It will take three years to be operational. It will provide one window facility service and trouble free business for investors.
- 3. Location of project.** The project is located in District Nowshera.
- 4. Date of filing of EIA.** 27/05/2009  
Ref. (EPA Diary No. 1922)
- 5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment of Marble City Risalpur District Nowshera of NWFP in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-**

  - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in EIA report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
  - b) The proponent must submit monthly compliance report.
  - c) Employment should be provided to local people particularly for unskilled jobs.
  - d) The solid waste should be disposed off in land fill area or hand over to Municipal Committee.
  - e) Tree plantation should be done in the open area.
  - f) Emissions and effluents if any should be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
  - g) A copy of agreement with cement industry about slurry use should be provided to this Agency.

- h) A copy of agreement about land acquisition should be provided to this Agency.
- i) Education and health facilities should be provided to the workers community.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
  7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
  8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
  9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, NWFP and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
  10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
  11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
  12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
  13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for Marble City Risalpur with above mentioned terms and conditions.
