2. **Description of project**

The project is planned to construct 220 KV Grid Station at D.I. Khan about 25 KM North West to D.I.Khan City, along the Indus Highway. The transmission line route will pass through the premises of D. I. Khan. The grid station will be constructed on 400 kanal of land.
3. **Location of project.**

The project is located at D.I. Khan about 25 KM North West to D.I.Khan City, along the Indus Highway

5. **After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment of "220 KV D.I. Khan Grid Station and Allied Transmission Line" in District D. I. Khan of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, subject to the following terms & conditions:-**
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in EIA report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
 - b) A Grievance Redressal Committee should be constituted with representative from EPA, NTDC and Revenue Department under the chair of Deputy Commissioner concerned to address the issue of land acquisition and compensation before starting the physical activities at project site.
 - c) Emergency response plan must be implemented according to plan submitted to this Agency.
 - d) Waste Management Plan and Monitoring Plan must be implemented according to plan submitted to this Agency.
 - e) Both skilled and unskilled employment shall be provided to locals.

f) Health and Safety measures like helmet, gloves, boots, first aid box etc should be provided to the staff.

g) Around the boundary walls trees must be planted at a distance of 10 feet.

6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.

7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.

8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.

9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.

10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.


11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
