**2. Description of project.**

The Shah 7 Plastic Industries (Pvt) Limited (oxo-biodegradable polythene bags manufacturing unit) is proposed to be established at plot No. 31/10, R-1, Gadoon Amazai Industrial Estate, District Swabi. Total area of the project is 1 acre in which 10850 ft<sup>2</sup> will be covered while the remaining will be open. Total capacity of the project is 500 kg per day.

**5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment report for the Shah 7 Plastic Industries (Pvt) Limited, Gadoon Industrial Estate, District Swabi, in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-**

- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phases of project.
  - b) The proponent must use virgin/new raw material for manufacturing of Oxo-biodegradable polythene bags only.
  - c) The proponent must not use waste/used plastic/materials for manufacturing polythene bags.
  - d) The self-monitoring report must be submitted to this Agency quarterly
  - e) Non-technical jobs must be provided to the local community.
  - f) The waste water/recycle water must be collected in the underground storage tanks after passing through machines and do not discharge directly to outside of the unit.
  - g) Health and safety measures through personal protection equipments must be provided to the staff during construction and operation stage.
  - h) The proponent must maintain its emission/effluents (if any) in compliance with National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
  - i) Waste water/effluents must be treated before discharging it outside the premises of the unit.
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- j) The proponent must be provided the mechanism for, oils & grease separation, collection of contaminated soil and its disposal procedure before starting physical activities.
- k) Mechanism and methodology for the safe disposal of solid waste must be provided to this Agency before starting the physical activities on the site.
- l) Sign boards regarding health safety must be installed in the sensitive area for the awareness of staff.
- m) The plantation must be carried out in the premises/around the boundary wall and in front of the factory. At least 100 evergreen plants must be planted.
- n) The proposed monitoring program in the EIA report must be strictly implemented.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant in the EIA Report/replies to the queries of this Agency.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the oxo-biodegradable polythene bags manufacturing unit only and not for normal or recycling polythene bags. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of Shah 7 Plastic Industries (Pvt) Limited, Gadoon Industrial Estate, District Swabi, with above mentioned terms and conditions.


