Decision on EIA


1. **Name, address of Proponent:** Muhammad Javed,
M/S Petrosin Edible Oil,
Plot No. 29/2, 29/3, Phase I & II,
Hattar Industrial Estate, District Haripur.
2. **Description of Project.** M/S Petrosin Edible Oil and Ghee
Industry intend to establish an Oil and
Ghee manufacturing Unit at Plot No.
29/2, 29/3, Phase-II Industrial Estate
Hattar, District Haripur. The proposed
Project will have a capacity of 80
M.tons per day. Total Area of the Project
is 2.75 Acre. The source of energy for
the proposed project will be provided
by WAPDA and a 400KVA Transformer
will be required for operational phase.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Haripur.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 21/01/2019 Ref. (EPA Diary No. 270)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact
Assessment of "**M/S Petrosin Edible Oil and Ghee Industry intend to
establish an Oil and Ghee manufacturing Unit at Plot No. 29/2, 29/3,
Phase-II, Industrial Estate Hattar, District Haripur**" in line with the
guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act,
2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms &
conditions:-
 - a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures
recommended in the EIA Report as well as replies of the proponent
submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during
the construction and operation phase of the project.
 - b) Pressurized water nozzle with automatic shut down shall be used for floor
cleaning in order to increase the efficiency of washing and save the water.

- c) Proper waste water treatment plant having capability of Primary and Secondary Treatment shall be installed before operationalization of the project.
 - d) Oil separator shall be installed for removal of oil and ghee contents in waste water and shall be regularly cleaned.
 - e) The proponent shall provide closed container to avoid uncontrolled dumping of waste and odor nuisance inside the plant and to ensure ultimate disposal to the designated site of KPEZDMC to avoid over spillage and dumping of waste in the containers' surroundings.
 - f) The proponent shall arrange awareness session among the employee regarding waste.
 - g) Waste Water pond/tank shall be cleaned on monthly basis and to dispose-off the sludge in designated place.
 - h) Raw oil tanks shall be cleaned every 3 months to minimize the degradation of oil and sludge formation.
 - i) Spent lubricant/oil which is considered hazardous waste shall only be sold to an authorized waste recycling facility.
 - j) Efficient separator shall be used for recovery of Nickel catalyst.
 - k) The proponent shall observe good housekeeping in the entire process of production.
 - l) Materials that may seep due to rains must be placed on concrete base in covered storage areas equipped with drainage systems, in order to avoid contamination of rain waters.
 - m) Areas for storing and handling of raw materials and products shall be waterproofed and concreted and have a drainage system, so that any spills and wash waters can be directed to treatment.
 - n) Noise pollution caused by equipment and operations that generate loud noise shall be controlled by caustic treatments by enclosure of equipment or soundproofing buildings. Machineries shall be properly maintained and lubricated.
 - o) Fire extinguishers, first aid box etc shall be installed inside the factory in case of any emergency.
 - p) Tree plantation shall be carried out in the open spaces of the factory.
 - q) Health and Safety Equipments shall be provided to the workers with the direction to use during working hours.
 - r) All effluents and emission shall be kept within NEQS permissible limits.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.

8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulations 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There shall no legal case pending in any court against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and , the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for construction phase of the said with above mentioned terms and conditions.
