



Decision on EIA

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Amin-ud-Din,
Director Engg-I, PDA

2. **Description of project.** The project is proposed to establish a Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF)/Composting Plant at Garhi Baghban (GTS Workshop), Peshawar on an area of 10 acres. The main activities of the project will include RDF, Compost preparation and recycling of recyclable materials (Plastic, Paper, Glass, bones etc). The capacity of the composting plant to absorb solid waste is 1000 MT/Day.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located at Garhi Baghban District Peshawar.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 16/02/2010
Ref. (EPA Diary No. 329)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment of Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF)/Composting Plant, of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of the project.
 - b) The proponent must submit monthly compliance report.
 - c) The centralized points for collection of solid waste should be away from the human settlements & the health related issues should be addressed.
 - d) Odour in the plant should be controlled at source to avoid nuisance in the surrounding of the plant.
 - e) The expected emission of gases like CO, CH₄, H₂S etc should be controlled at source.
 - f) Medical center/Dispensary as well as mosque should be established in the plant for the workers and should be allowed to the local people to get benefit from it.
 - g) Occupational health & safety should be ensured.
 - h) The transportation of solid waste should be ensured in specialized vehicles as suggested to avoid dispersion on road during shifting it to the plant.
 - i) Employment should be provided to local people particularly for non-technical jobs.

- j) The plants/trees on the boundaries & in the middle of the plot should be protected; however, ornamental/evergreen plants should be planted in the project area.
- k) Effluents if any should be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- l) Microbial misting spray should be installed to absorb the foul smell.
- m) Mosquitoes and flies repellent spray should be arranged inside the project area and in the surrounding area on regular basis.
- n) Proper arrangement should be made for the management of leachetes as to safeguard the surrounding water quality. The leachets should not be allowed for disposal outside the project.
- o) A buffer zone should be developed between the village and the composite plant. Special arrangements should be made for the incoming and outgoing vehicles so that it does not disturb the existing road of the village along the boundary wall.
- p) Quarterly report regarding the existing air quality and water quality in the surrounding area should be submitted to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
9. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
10. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
11. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
12. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for Refuse Derived Fuel/Composting Plant with above mentioned terms and conditions.
