Decision on EIA

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Col. (R) Ahmad Javed,
General Manager,
National Highway Authority House
632, Street # 3 Sector G-11/1,
Islamabad.
2. **Description of project.** The project is for
rehabilitation of Bisian- Balakot-
Kaghan- Naran Section of National
Highway N-15 damaged by the
earthquake of October 8,2005. The
length of the damaged section of
the highway is 65 Km, starting
from Bisian and ending at Naran.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in
District Mansehra.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 13/02/2008
(Ref: EPA/Dairy No.303)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of
NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact
Assessment for Rehabilitation of earthquake damaged road Bisian-
Balakot-Kaghan-Naran Road (N-15) in District Mansehra in line with
the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000
subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures
identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during
the construction and operation phase of project.
 - b) The debries should be properly disposed off in 7 locations and
details of the same should be provided to this agency and must be
properly labeled.
 - c) Breast walls & retaining walls should be constructed and the
detail/location of thee structures should be provided to this agency.
 - d) 180 Sign board size 4.5 into 3 feet should be installed on the road
side for avoiding accidents.
 - e) List of Affected people (who's land are taken/tree cutted) should be
provided to this agency.

- f) Detail of compensation to the affected people in term of land & trees should be provided to this agency.
- g) Water channel for smooth flow of water should be maintained in the road side/ area.
- h) The proponent should provide copy of land agreement made with property owner if land acquisition is involved.
- i) Certification for restoration of site after completion of the activity should be submitted to this Agency.
- j) Site camp should be located away from the residential area.
- k) There should be proper and regular sprinkling of water for the control of dust pollution.
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 13, 14 & 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations 2000, which enunciate the conditions for approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring of the proposed project.
7. This approval does not absolve the proponent of duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any other law in force.
8. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is please to approve the EIA report of the project with above mentioned terms & conditions
