1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Jawad Karim,

2. **Description of project.** The project is proposed to manufacture phosphate fertilizer under the name of Royal Chemicals. The plant will manufacture agriculture related products. The estimated cost of the project is 50 million and total area is 2 acre.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located at 75-B, Phase III, Hattar Industrial Estate, District Haripur.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 06-11-2014,  
(Ref. EPA Diary No. 815)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment report for Royal Chemicals, District Haripur, under the provision of Section 13 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
  - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operational phases of project.
  - b) Both technical and non technical jobs must be provided to the local community.
  - c) Plantation must be carried out as recommended in the EIA Report.
  - d) Health and safety measures shall be ensured during construction and operational stage.
  - e) Sign boards reflecting names of chemical and precautionary measures must be installed.
  - f) Chemicals must be kept in a safe place.

- g) Empty chemical's containers/bags/bottles and expired chemicals must not be thrown outside the boundary wall of the unit, rather these shall be disposed off properly.
- h) Waste water/effluents shall be treated and disposed off.
- i) The cow dung must be dried outside the unit/industrial estate and only dry material has to be transported for mixing with fertilizer.

6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. This approval is accorded subject to the condition that there is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of Royal Chemicals with above mentioned terms and conditions.
