
Decision on EIA

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Hayat Ahmad,
Senior Manager Exploration
Pakistan Petroleum Limited,
PIDC House, Dr. Zia Uddin Ahmad
Road, Karachi.
2. **Description of project.** Pakistan Petroleum Limited plan to undertake seismic survey and oil/gas exploratory drilling in Zindan Concession Block 3270-7 which is spread over districts of Lakki Marwat and D.I.Khan in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province and Mianwali and Bhakhar in Punjab.
3. **Location of project.** The proposed project is located in districts of Lakki Marwat and D.I.Khan in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province.
4. **Date of filing of EIA.** 07-09-2010
(Ref: EPA/Dairy No.997).
5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment for seismic survey and oil/gas exploratory drilling in Zindan Concession Block 3270-7 in districts of Lakki Marwat and D.I.Khan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
 - b) The compensation for crops, trees and land should be paid on the market rate/ as per government policy.
 - c) Compensation should be provided to affectees before commencement of any drilling activity/seismic survey in the project area.
 - d) Compensation amount should be well advertised in local mosque/ hujra as committed in the letter submitted to this Agency and report be submitted to this Agency after completion of the process.
 - e) Non technical jobs should be provided to the local communities.
 - f) Plantation should be carried out along the road side for the compensation of the trees lost. The number of tree planted should be at least five times of the trees lost.

Proponent will be responsible to facilitate EPA team for any visit, inspection/monitoring etc.

- h) Seismic survey should be carried out in sensitive/reserve area after consultation with concerned departments.
 - i) Area should be restored after completion of survey/activities.
 - j) Sprinkling of water on the road should be carried out on regularly basis.
 - k) The proponent of the project will ensure to provide health safety equipment to the staff like rubber shoes, gloves, overall and ear plugs.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
