



Decision on IEE

2. **Description of project:** MOL Pakistan Oil & Gas Company B.V has planned to
drill Razgir-1 Well at Razgir Banda, Tehsil Seni Gumbat
District Kohat. The well will be connected through a
flow line to Tolanj Processing Facility of MOL Pakistan.
The length of the flow line will be 18 Km. Main
objectives of the proposed activities are to determine the
presence of recoverable Hydrocarbons and to improve
the Hydrocarbon production of the Tal Block.
3. **Location of project:** The project is located in District Kohat.

5. After a careful review and field visit carried out by Mr. Essa Khan, Monitoring Inspector,
EPA Southern Directorate D.I.Khan, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional construction Environmental
approval of the Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) report of "Razgir-1 well and
associated flow line activities in Tal Block, District Kohat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa," in line
with the guidelines issued under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014
and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
- All the precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE Report as well as any
unanticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of the Project must
be implemented.
 - Copy of the Land Documents/Lease Agreement must be provided to this office before
starting physical activities at the site.
 - Non Technical Jobs must be provided to the Land Owners/concerned Village/Union
Council and preference shall also be given in technical jobs to the local people of the
area;
 - The Well site/area must be restored in the original form after completion of the project
activities or failure of the project and the Report must be submitted to this office;

- e) Health and safety measures/Personal Protection Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to the workers during working hours.
- f) Plantation must be carried out around the project area and shall take-care of the same.
- g) Compensation to the owners of tree/crop must be provided before starting physical activities on the site and Report be submitted to this office along with their complete addresses;
- h) Detail of the CSR activities in the proposed project area must be provided to this office before starting the operational activities;
- i) Sprinkling of Water must be carried out on the dusty road daily basis;
- j) Ground water, water bodies and soil must be protected from explosive/chemicals/hazardous materials;
- k) Solid waste, Produced water and Contaminated mud of the project must be treated and disposed of as per the procedures mentioned in the supplementary/additional documents;
- l) The proposed activities must not be carried out in the Sensitive/Reserved Forest area and disputed Land etc;
- m) The NOC from Mine and Minerals, Forest and Wildlife Department if required under the Law must be obtained before starting the physical activities ;
- n) Social/cultural life/Parda must not be disturbed;
- o) All the emissions/effluents (if any) shall be kept within the permissible limits of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- p) The proponent shall be responsible to facilitate the EPA team during visit/inspection/monitoring.




6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the Environmental Consultant in the IEE Report.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 11,13,14,17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulation 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.

13. The EPA will monitor the conditions of Environmental Approval/issues at anytime without prior information;
14. In exercise of the power under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
