Kindly refer to your application No. Nil dated 23/07/2020, regarding the issuance of Environmental approval and to state that after fulfillment of the requirements of administrative penalty of Rs. 100,000/- for violation of Section-13 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014. This Agency is pleased to accord trial basis operational approval to the subject unit for the period of Forty-Five (45) days at production capacity of 06tons/day, with the following terms & conditions;

1. The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EMP Report and replies submitted to this Agency in response of observations raised on the EMP Report.
2. Sign boards regarding Health Safety shall be installed in the sensitive area for the awareness of staff.
3. Solid Waste shall be properly dumped in designated area.
4. All the effluents & emissions shall be kept within the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
5. Store raw/crushed materials in yard/hall and cover the same with tarpaulin sheet to avoid dust pollution.
6. Provide Personal Protective Equipments (Mask, Gloves, Shoes, etc.) to the workers with a direction to use in working hours.

7. Twenty (20) number of different plants shall be planted in open spaces/surrounding of the Project and protect the existing vegetation (if any).
8. Health and safety report of the workers shall be submitted to this Agency every 06 months after operationalization of the Unit.
9. To avoid dust pollution, dust pollution control system (i.e. Fabric filter, Cyclone and Dust Control Rooms) shall be installed at the Unit and the emission limit shall be within the Environmental parameters.
10. In case of any extension in the unit or change of product, inform this Agency before commencement of any activity.
11. In case any complaint received regarding the deleterious environment of the unit or any nuisance being created, this Agency reserved the right to cancel the Environmental Approval in best public interest.
12. Employment shall be provided to the local people in technical/non technical jobs.
13. During the trial basis operation, EPA Laboratory shall visit the unit for checking the compliance of NEQS and the case will be processed on the basis of the visit report for full time operational approval or otherwise. Furthermore, this Agency may propose further mitigation measures in the light of visit report of EPA Laboratory staff.
