Subject: **ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVAL FOR AHMED CONTROL POULTRY SHED DISTRICT MARDAN**

Reference to your letter No. Nil dated 23-04-2018 on the subject cited above and to state that this Agency allows operational activities of the said unit. However, the following mitigation measures shall be adopted for Environmental protection and improvement:

1. The unit must comply with the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS) for emission and effluents.
2. The Power Generators shall be properly enclosed to avoid noise pollution. Moreover, the generators shall be shifted away from residential side.
3. Separate areas shall be designated/specified for raw material and poultry feed.
4. Stock/Inventory registers for all the raw materials & by products shall be maintained.
5. Safety and Emergency measures shall be adopted in the premises of the project area e.g. emergency exits, fire extinguisher etc.
6. The boundary wall height shall be further increased up to maximum possible height.
7. Further plantation (buffer zones) shall be carried out along the boundary wall towards the residential area to mitigate the possible smell. Thick plantation (of two rows) spaced apart not more than three meters shall be carried out around boundary of the poultry farm.

8. Proper enclosed vehicles shall be used in transport of the poultry faeces/litter of the chicks and the waste shall be properly fumigated before transport.
9. Effluent shall not be discharge out directly to the outside nullah/drain without prior treatment.
10. Proper site shall be identified for disposal/burial of dead chicks.
11. The sheds shall be properly fumigated prior to transport the poultry waste/litter.
12. Personal Protective Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to all workers to ensure health and safety with direction to use during working hours and inventory registers shall be maintained for ready reference.
13. Any change in the project design or extension shall be communicated to this Agency for approval.
14. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that shall be required under any law in force.
15. Environmental Approval will be cancelled if any or all of the above conditions is/are not complied with.
16. If any complaint received regarding deleterious environment of the unit, the approval may be cancelled.

Furthermore the monitoring team of this agency will carry out routine monitoring to check the compliance of above mentioned mitigation measures. In case of non-compliance, action shall be initiated under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014.
