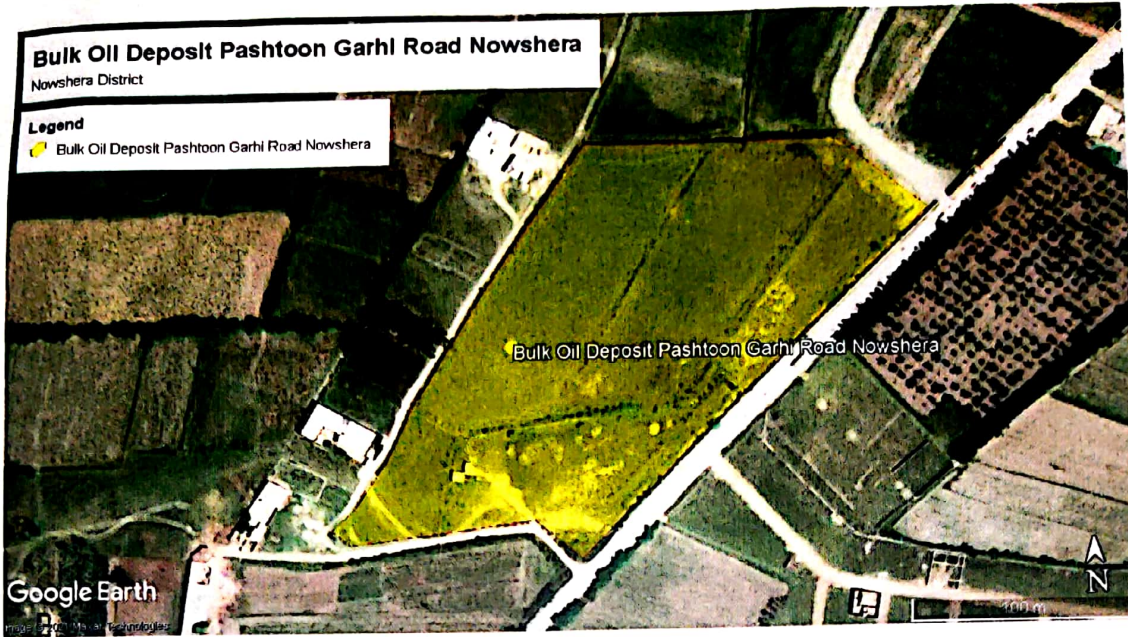


## SCHEDULE-V

### Decision on IEE

1. **Name, Address of proponent:** Mr. Malik Shahzad Azhar,  
Manager (Admin & HR), Attock  
Petroleum Limited.

2. **Description of project.** M/S Attock Petroleum Limited  
(APL) intends to  
construct/Operate Bulk Oil  
storage depot at Pashtun Ghari,  
Pabbi, District Nowshera. The  
site has a total area of above 63  
Kanal and 18 Marlas owned by  
APL. APL as a private entity for  
storage and management of Oil  
stocks. Total water requirements  
during the construction work will  
approximately 1655 m<sup>3</sup>. The total  
cost of the proposed project as  
RS. 400 Million.
3. **Location of Project.** The Project is located in District  
Nowshera Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

5. **Date of filing of IEE.** 01/06/2020 Ref. (EPA Diary No. 304)

After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination of "**Attock Petroleum Limited**" of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as per above mentioned **GPS coordinates/GIS Map** in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in the IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operational phase of the project.
- b) Bulk Oil Depot will be constructed by maintaining the maximum possible safest distance by keeping in view the rules and regulation for oil storage/handling facility of OGRA and explosives departments (applicable to all over Pakistan).
- c) All kinds of oil-fuel storage tanks shall be constructed at least 100m distance from the residential houses. Furthermore, 100m buffer zone shall be maintained from the residential houses in future.
- d) Before commencement of the project No Objection Certificate will be obtain from the explosive department.



- e) Ensure pardah system of the locals. Watch/security towers, etc. shall be constructed at suitable places in order to avoid any disturbance of pardah system.
  - f) Proper buffer zone of at least 10m towards the residential houses shall be maintained within the boundary wall of the proposed project site.
  - g) Plantation shall be carried out in site the buffer zone.
  - h) A grievances redressal committee with having representation of the locals shall be constituted to record and redress the grievance of locals through mutual consensus.
  - i) Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the locals and shall also be preferred in technical jobs.
  - j) Health & safety equipments like rubber shoes, gloves, overall and ear plugs etc must be provided to the staff.
  - k) The Plantation must be carried out as per recommendation in the IEE Report.
  - l) The proponent must bring its emissions, if any, in compliance with National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
  - m) Sign boards must be installed on the sensitive areas for guidance of the workers as well as visitors.
  - n) Security must be provided and fire extinguishers must be installed at appropriate points.
  - o) Mitigation measures must be adopted to control leakages during Improper refueling.
  - p) There shall be nothing repugnant to any Govt. order or policy on subject.
- 6.** The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
- 7.** The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
- 8.** This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the

project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.

9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
