- 1 Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Sajjad Ullah,

- 2. Description of project.** The proposed project of **Sajjad & Brother Poultry Control Shed** will be established at Isamlia road, Tehsil Razar, District Swabi on 12 kanals area of which total covered area will be 21840 square feet. About 27000 broilers will be raised in the environmentally controlled shed. The present sanctioned load of the proposed project is 100 KVA supplied by the water and power Development Authority (WAPDA). In order to meet the emergency as well as critical power requirements during WAPDA shutdown the projects also proposed to install stand by generator.
- 3. Location of project.** The proposed project is located, District Swabi
- 4. GPS boundary Coordinates.** 34°12'21.58" N, 72°13'40.36"
- 5. Date of filing of IEE.** 31-08-2020 (EPA Ref diary: No. 507)
- 6.** After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional approval of the Initial Environmental Examination IEE Report for "**Sajjad & Brother Poultry Control Shed**, located at Isamlia road, Tehsil Razar, District Swabi, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report, in the replies submitted by the proponent as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- b) The proponent shall be bound to control its emissions/effluents of the poultry shed, if any, and of the generator. All the emissions and effluents shall not exceed the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
- c) Poultry waste (litters etc) shall not be left in open atmosphere, near residential area and shall be stored in confined area for further disposal at designated site.
- d) Raw material/poultry feed during transportation shall be covered.
- e) Tunnel ventilation system shall be installed to control bad smell inside the poultry shed.
- f) The submitted mitigation plan for control of odor shall be fully implemented. Furthermore, fumigants shall be used inside the shed(s) and poultry waste of the unit.
- g) A buffer zone covered with trees shall be established towards the residential site and at least 200 plants shall be planted (heighted and fast growing species) in available spaces/around the boundary wall, in front of the unit especially towards the exhaust fans, residential area etc.
- h) The proponent shall not discharge untreated waste water into the surface water body. Settling tanks shall be constructed for effluents treatment. The treated water should be reused for watering of lawn and trees.
- i) Traffic management plan shall be strictly followed to avoid traffic congestion and transportation vehicles shall be parked inside the unit at specified area.
- j) Stock/Inventory registers for all the raw materials shall be maintained.
- k) Dead chicken shall be buried/treated in confined pits inside the premises of the unit and shall not be dumped/disposed off outside the unit.
- l) Personal Protective Equipments (PPEs) shall be provided to the staff during construction and operation stage/phase.
- m) Sign boards regarding Health Safety shall be installed in the sensitive area for the awareness of staff.
- n) Safety and Emergency measures shall be adopted in the premises of the project area.
- o) Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) shall be strictly followed.

- p) Any other measures as suggested by this Agency shall be followed during construction/operation stage.
7. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided in the environmental report.
 8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 9. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulations 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that shall be required under any law in force.
 13. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 14. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report of the said project with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
