2. **Description of project.** The Shah Kaleem Dam is proposed to be constructed on Shah Kaleem Khawar which is locally known as Pitao Khwar. The life of the Dam is estimated to be more than 30 years. It will have gross storage of 646 AF. The water from the Dam devivor can cater for irrigating 600 acres.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Nowshera.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 04/06/2009
EPA (Diary No.1971)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination for Shah Kaleem Dam, District Nowshera, in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
 - b) Proper mitigation measures should be adopted to protect two primary schools (one Boys, one Girls) and Pitao payan village.
 - c) Tube well & irrigation land should be protected or properly compensated through mutual agreement with owners if any damage occur.
 - d) Grave yard & electric poles issues should be solved through constitution with local people of area and WAPDA.
 - e) Present right of way of irrigation should be protected.
 - f) Land compensation agreement should be provided to this Agency before starting activities on the site.
 - g) To minimize erosion, afforestation programme should be planed and implemented in the catchments area of the proposed dam.
 - h) The dam site is hardly located 200 meter from the Pitao payan village therefore, proper protection should be provided for the village people before starting the physical activities.
 - i) Proper compensation should be provided to the owner of electric tube well and irrigated agricultural land.

- j) Alternate road should be provided to the people of the area.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, NWFP and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE of Shah Kaleem Dam with above mentioned terms and conditions.
