- 2. Description of project.** The proposed Solid Waste Management Project is a pilot activity in collaboration with Local Government/TMA in Guli Bagh area of Mardan. The capacity of the project is to treat three tons of organic waste per day through aerobic decomposition.
- 3. Location of project.** The project is located in District Mardan.
- 4. Date of filing of IEE.** 01/11/2012
(Ref. EPA Diary No. 04)
- 5.** After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the "Initial Environmental Examination of Solid Waste Management Project, having a capacity to process less than 10000 cubic meters of Municipal Solid Waste annually in Guli Bagh, Mardan", in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phases of project.
 - b) The solid waste management activity must not be carried out in the existing Tehsil Municipal Administration Treatment Plant located in the Guli Bagh Mardan.
 - c) A buffer zone must be established between the effluent treatment plant and solid waste management area/plot.
 - d) A boundary wall must be constructed around the solid waste management activity.
 - e) The solid waste brought to the area must be fully covered so that waste must not be spread all over the way.
 - f) Both Recyclable and unrecyclable materials must not be spread around the solid waste management area/plot.

- g) Exact date of commencement and completion period of the activity must be provided to this Agency before starting the project/physical activities.
 - h) Agreement with the TMA/District Government must be provided to this Agency before starting the project activities.
 - i) Bad smell must be controlled with proper chemicals/plantation etc in the area.
 - j) Staff must be provided proper training and health & safety equipments.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
