1. **Name, address of proponent:** The Executive Engineer
Warsak Canal Division, Peshawar
Warsak Lift Canal Sub Division,
Irrigation Department Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa.

2. **Description of project.** The proposed project namely
"Remodeling and Extension of Warsak
Left Bank Canal District Peshawar/
Charsadda (ADP No. 1524 (2016-17))"
takes off directly from the Warsak Dam
Reservoir through an Intake Structure
fixed in the main body of the dam, to the
left of the Kabul River. Canal remodeling
includes the following:
 - a) Increasing the capacity of canal;
 - b) Repair of the existing canal lining;
 - c) Lining of earthen sections of the canal;
 - d) Construction of abandoned reach of the canal from RD 53+000 to RD 92+000;
 - e) Extension of the canal beyond RD 92+000;
 - f) Providing service road from RD 30+000 to RD 53+000;
 - g) Stone pitching of the deep cut reaches of the canal and repair of the existing conduit located between RD 30+000 and RD 33+000;
 - h) Repair of the escape structures;

3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Peshawar, Charsadda and Mohmand

4. **Date of filing of IEE** 09/06/2020

5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the IEE Report for "**Remodeling and Extension of Warsak Left Bank Canal District Peshawar/Charsadda (ADP No. 1524 (2016-17))**" for construction phase, in line with the Khyber

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Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the IEE Report as well as replies of the proponent submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the remodeling and extension of the existing canal.
- b) All conflicting issues regarding compensation, lease agreement etc to be settled before commencing the physical activities and a certificate in this regard should be submitted to this Agency.
- c) If any issues come up during execution of the project the proponent shall be made bound to address those issues which are unforeseen and not identified in the IEE Report.
- d) Safety of the social & cultural life of the local community shall be ensured.
- e) Any damage to the bridge, road or any other existing facility and its restoration plan should be provided to this Agency before starting physical work.
- f) The proponent must ensure to avoid dumping of debris unattended. The same shall be reused in construction activity of the proposed project or a proper area should be identified for disposal of debris. The same shall be shared with this Agency.
- g) The proponent should ensure the strict and efficient health and safety measures for the protection of workers and passers by backed by a comprehensive emergency response plan, e.g. helmets, signboards and shoes etc.
- h) The project shall be executed within RoW of Irrigation Department.
- i) A minimum of 125 trees shall be planted along the Canal side and available space.
- j) The water flow shall be maintained in a way to fulfill water Rights of all the dependants.
- k) Efforts shall be taken to avoid discharge of effluents and solid waste into the canal water. The land shall be cleaned after regular intervals.
- l) Mitigation measures shall be adopted to ensure safety of human life as per submitted Flood Protection Plan
- m) Skilled/unskilled jobs must be offered to the local community first and if not available locally can be filled from outside.
- n) The proponent shall provide the copy of this approval and IEE report to the contractor for information and compliance.

6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
9. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
10. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
11. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
12. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
