1. **Name, Address of Proponent:** Mr. Gabor Vackarcs,

2. **Description of Project.** MOL Pakistan Oil and Gas Company B.V intended drilling of Makori Deep-02 Well and laying of associated Flow line from the proposed well to Makori Value Assembly and construction of supplementary wellhead/surface facilities. Drilling of Makori Deep-02 well will involve a customarily practice of mobilizing a construction contractor/s for the development of access route, base camp, rig camp, well site facilities which is followed by installation of all parts, units, equipments and rigging up of 2000hp diesel electric rig, drilling will commence at Makori Deep-02 well using conventional drilling techniques with water & oil based mud system. The entire drilling operation will complete in approximately 10 months. Makori Deep-02 well will be connected through flow line to Makori Value Assembly of MOL Pakistan in the area. The expected length of the flow line will be 4.4km.
3. **Location of Project.** The project is located in District Karak.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 09-08-2019 (Ref EPA/Diary No. 618)
5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional approval of the Initial Environmental Examination for "Drilling of Makori Deep-2 Well and Associated Laying of Flow Line Activities in Tal Block, District Karak Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" in line with the guidelines issued by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.

- b) The proponent shall provide copy of agreement between MOL Pakistan and the local people along-with their complete addresses of the area regarding land/crop compensation and compensation procedure to this Agency before starting physical activities.
- c) Agreement for land acquisition shall be finalized before commencement of project activities
- d) The proponent of the project shall ensure to provide safety equipments to the staff like rubber shoes/boots, gloves, glasses etc.
- e) The affected area shall be restored/rehabilitated in the original form after the completion of drilling activity and present Right of Way (RoW) shall not be disturbed.
- f) Mitigation measures shall be adopted for soil erosion and land sliding in the access track.
- g) Flow line option shall be finalized before commencement of the project under intimation to this Agency.
- h) The proponent will be bound to control its emission/effluents if any, ~~not~~ exceeding the permissible limit of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
- i) The effluent waste and produced water should be stored in confined/enclosed membrane pits and shall be disposed off after proper treatment.
- j) Solid waste/Debris/Excavated material shall be disposed off at designated site.
- k) Wildlife protected areas shall not be disturbed.
- l) Air, Soil and Water bodies must be protected from all kinds of contamination.
- m) Sprinkling of water on the road must be carried out on regularly basis.
- n) Plantation plan alongwith plant species and numbers to be planted must be submitted before the start of physical activities.
- o) Non-Technical jobs must be provided to the local people of the area.
- p) Social uplift program should be carried out with consultation of local community.

- q) The monitoring team of this Agency will regularly visit the project site to check the terms and conditions of the approval and compliance of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Agency, 2014.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided in the environmental report.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000; regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Regulation 13 (2) (b) and 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report t with above mentioned terms and conditions.
