Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Karapa Plaster of Paris, Jatta Ismail Khel, Old Bannu Road District Karak

2. **Description of project.** The proposed Factory is situated at Jatta Ismail khel old Bannu road District Karak and it is 75 feet from main road. From three sides factory is surrounded by barren areas.
3. **Location of project.** The proposed Factory is located at Jatta Ismail Khel Old Bannu Road District Karak.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 12-05-2008


5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of NWFP has decided to accord conditional approval of the Initial Environmental Examination for Karapa Plaster of Paris, District Karak in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in the IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- b) The proponent will install factory in the area of 5 Kanal. In the factory there will be one Hall whose area will be about 90×45 feet and height 20 feet.
- c) A dust control system be made with a special exhaust fan to suck all the dust for settling in a dust control room having a size 50 x 15 feet and height 20 feet. They system should always be in operational conditions.
- d) During stone crushing process the machine be at low speed to prevent dust as well as noise Pollution and sprinkling of water be ensured.
- e) During Calcination, pressure of the gas should be reduced, and kettles be rotated at low speed to prevent dust and noise pollution.

- f) Keep grinding machine at low speed to prevent dust pollution
 - g) Use fabric (Bag house) filter or electrostatic precipitator
 - h) Health and Safety measure should be provide to the staff.
 - i) Trees should be planted inside the premises of the factory along the boundary walls for the control of dust movement through wind.
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 13, 14 & 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations 2000, which enunciate the conditions for approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring of the proposed project.
7. This approval does not absolve the proponent of duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any other law in force.
8. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE report of the project with above mentioned terms & conditions.
