


## SCHEDULE-VI

### Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Ashiq Hussain Shah,  
Deputy Director-II,  
Foreign Aided Projects,  
Works and Services Department,  
House#163, St#9, Sector N-3,  
Phase-IV  
Hayatabad, Peshawar.
  
2. **Description of project.** The IEE of LCB-34 road from  
Purana Azim Killa to Walgai  
Musa Khel Distt. Bannu  
comprises 7.793 Km in  
length passing through  
barren land. The proposed  
road will be constructed on  
the existing used track within  
the available right of way.  
Since the land ownership on  
the Govt. name is not  
confirmed according to the  
revenue department. Total of  
4.15 Ha non-irrigated land  
following in 3 Mauzas will be  
acquired through LAC District  
Bannu. For this purpose an  
amount of Rs. 1.721 Million  
has been reserved.
  
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in  
District Bannu.
  
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 29/07/2008
  
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt.  
of NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Initial  
Environmental Examination for Construction and improvement of  
LCB-34 Road from Purana Azim Killa to Walgai Musa Khel District  
Bannu ADB Loan No.2103-Pak (OCR) in line with the guidelines  
issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the  
following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
  - b) The debries should be properly disposed off.
  - c) The proponent should provide copy of land agreement made with property owner if land acquisition is involved.
  - d) Submission certification for restoration of site after completion of the activity.
  - e) Site camp will be located away from the residential area.
  - f) There should be proper and regular sprinkling of water for the control of dust pollution.
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 13, 14 & 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations 2000, which enunciate the conditions for approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring of the proposed project.
  7. This approval does not absolve the proponent of duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any other law in force.
  8. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is please to approve the IEE report of the project with above mentioned terms & conditions
