### Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Ashiq Hussain Shah,  
Deputy Director-II,  
Foreign Aided Projects,  
Works and Services Department,  
House#163, St#9, Sector N-3,  
Phase-IV  
Hayatabad, Peshawar.
  
2. **Description of project.** The LCB-44 road from Ahmad Abad Chowk to village Danda District Karak covering total length of 10.749km out of which about 5km of the road is metalled and remaining road is composed of Kacha, snady and clayey track. The existing road passes through plain area. The road will be constructed on the current used track within the available ROW. A total of 65.25 kanal non-irrigated (barani land) following in 3 mauzas will be acquired through LAC District Karak. For this Purpose an amount of Rs. 2.504 million will be deposited to the LAC for disbursement to the affected persons.
  
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Karak.
  
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 02/08/2008
  
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of NWFP has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination for Construction and improvement of LCB-44 Road from Ahmad Abad Chowk to village Danda District Karak, ADB Loan No.2103-Pak (OCR) in line with the guidelines

Issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
  - b) The debries should be properly disposed off.
  - c) The proponent should provide copy of land agreement made with property owner if land acquisition is involved.
  - d) Submission certification for restoration of site after completion of the activity.
  - e) Site camp will be located away from the residential area.
  - f) There should be proper and regular sprinkling of water for the control of dust pollution.
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of section 13, 14 & 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations 2000, which enunciate the conditions for approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring of the proposed project.
  7. This approval does not absolve the proponent of duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any other law in force.
  8. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is please to approve the IEE report of the project with above mentioned terms & conditions
