Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Director General,
Small Dams Organization,
Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa,
Peshawar.
H#03 Afzal Abad Old Bara Road,
University Town, Peshawar.
2. **Description of project.** Sumari Payan Dam is planned to be built on Sumari Toi (stream) near Sumari Payan village. The stream bed elevation is 1765 ft. above sea level. It will have gross storage of 5066 acre ft. The creation of Reservoir will result in submergence of 223 acre of land including 50 acre of cultivated land. The life of the Dam is estimated to be 30 years (30% reduction of gross storage). The dam water can cater for irrigating purpose.
3. **Location of project.** The project is located in District Kohat.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 24-02-2011
(Ref. EPA Diary No. 394)
5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination for Sumari Payan Dam, District Kohat, in line with the guidelines issued by Pak. EPA and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000 subject to the following terms & conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phases of project.
 - b) Present right of way of irrigation should be protected.
 - c) Debris should be disposed off in pit or designated areas.
 - d) Non technical jobs should be provided to the local community.
 - e) Compensation of the land should be paid on market rate/ as per govt. policy.
 - f) Afforestation programme should be planned and implemented in the catchments area of the proposed dam.
 - g) Special measures should be taken to mitigate the Air, Water and Noise pollution.

- h) Health and safety measures (PPEs) should be provided to the worker during working hours.
- i) The proponent should be responsible to facilitate the EPA team during visit/inspection/monitoring.
- j) Community infrastructure damaged during construction phase should be restored/relocated.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 12 of the Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
