
Decision on IEE

1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Akos Grosz,
Managing Director, MOL Pakistan Oil &
Gas Co. B.V. Plot No. 5/A Crown Plaza,
F-7 Markaz, P.O. Box 1562, Islamabad.
2. **Description of project.** The proposed Tolaj Processing Facility
is located near Gumbat in District Kohat.
The objectives of the project is to process
and market natural gas from the Tolanj-1
natural gas well and other planned wells in
the near vicinity. The total area to be
acquired for the TPF is about 40,000
square meters. The proposed drilling
operation is carried out to estimate the
potential for gas in the region with the
reference to existing production.
3. **Location of project.** The proposed project is located in
Tal Block, District Kohat, Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa.
4. **Date of filing of IEE.** 14-04-2015
(Ref: EPA/Dairy No.204).
5. After a careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord conditional approval of the Initial
Environmental Examination of Tolanj Processing Facility, in District Kohat of Khyber
Pakhtunkhwa in line with Section 13 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental
Protection Act, 2014 and IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, subject to the following terms
& conditions:-
 - a) The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in
IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and
operation phase of project.
 - b) The proponent must provide copy of agreement between MOL Pakistan and the
local people of the area regarding land / crop compensation along with their
complete addresses to this Agency.
 - c) The drilling activity should not be carried out in the sensitive/reserved forest
area during construction phase.
 - d) Air quality data must be provided as a bench mark to establish baseline of the
project area before starting construction activities.
 - e) The consultant already hired by MOL shall carry out impacts study of the bio-
remediation plant in addition to the study on water balance and submit report
accordingly.
 - f) Sprinkling of water on the road should be carried out on regular basis.

- g) Over extraction of water should be avoided for the use of this project.
 - h) Present community water resources and perennial plans should not be disturbed.
 - i) Both technical and non technical jobs should be provided to the local people of the area.
 - j) Area should be restored in the original form after the completion of project activities.
 - k) Social/cultural life (Parda) of the area should be respected.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the proponent.
 7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Sections 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
 8. This approval is accorded only for the installation/ construction phase of the project. The proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Section 13 (2) (b) and Section 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000. The proponent must inform this agency when construction phase is completed.
 9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
 11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 12. That there is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
 13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of the project with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
