**Subject: Operational Approval for Dargai Polymer (Pvt) Limited.**

Whereas in response to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Tribunal (KP-EPT) Judgment No: Nil dated: 19/06/2019 and to your application No Nil dated: 20/09/2019, on the above noted subject and to state that in the light of observations raised, comments and reply submitted by you on Environmental Management Plan, this office is pleased to allow you to operate your unit; Dargai Polymer Pvt. Ltd at Plot No:55,56& 57, Small Industrial Estate, Dargai District Malakand (GPS Coordinates: 34 30 49.12N, 71 54 57.98E) on the basis of the following mitigation measures for the improvement and protection of Environment as per Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014.

1. The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) report as well as replies of the proponent submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the operation phase of the project.
2. You are allowed to manufacture the oxo-biodegradable plastic bags in natural shade only.
3. You must comply with the "Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Prohibition of Non-biodegradable Plastic Product and Oxo-biodegradable Plastic Products Rules, 2017".
4. You should submit sample of oxo-biodegradable plastic bags of each batch to EPA for checking against the plastic rules, 2017.
5. Thickness of your manufactured shopping bags should not be less than 50 microns single sheet.
6. Your product shall be prominently marked, oxo-biodegradable, company name and shall bear the identification mark or logo of supplier of the pro-degrading additive.
7. Necessary arrangement for proper ventilation in unit must be carried out.
8. Personal Protection Equipments must be provided to the labors/ workers of the unit.
9. Plantation must be carried out according to Plantation Plan given in Environmental Management Plan.
10. Solid waste must be collected and safely disposed off on regular basis.
11. Any change/ extension in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.

The Environmental Protection Agency reserves the right to check and to ensure the implementation of pollution control measures at the project area. Moreover, in case of non compliance with any of the above mentioned conditions, this approval will be considered null and void, and legal action will be initiated as per Provision of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, in this regard an undertaking must be submitted to this Agency within a month on Stamp Paper as an undertaking for the compliance of terms and conditions as mentioned in the Environmental Approval as well as mitigation measures proposed in the EMP Report.
