SUB: MITIGATION MEASURES FOR OPERATING OF KHALEEJ STEEL INDUSTRY PVT. LTD, PLOT NO. 74,78,79 and 80, SMALL INDUSTRIAL ESTATE DARGAI, TEHSIL DARGAI, DISTRICT MALAKAND.

Kindly, refer to your application No. Nill, dated: 04/04/2022 along with the IEE Report of Khaleej Steel Industry Pvt. Ltd (Steel Pipe Mill) and to the presentation held in the office of the undersigned on 19/05/2022, followed by observation conveyed to you vide this office letter No.EPA/ROS/IEE/3064 dated 21/06/2022, and your reply vide letter No. Nill, dated: 01/08/2022 regarding the clarification of the observations that are raised during in the presentation of your Steel Pipe Mill, and the visits of the EPA officers/ officials to the project area, it is evident, that your project named Khaleej Steel Industry Pvt. Ltd (Steel Pipe Mill only) is involved in manufacturing of steel tube and pipes by uncoiling readymade material (Sheets), cutting and welding process and not implicated in any furnace or re-rolling activities.

While meticulously study the Schedules of Pak EPA IEE/ EIA Regulations, 2000 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, the above mentioned facility/project does not listed in any of the category of projects requiring GEA, IEE or EIA. However, you are directed under section-17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 to comply with the provisions of Section-11 of the Act *ibid*.

As the unit exist and already in operation, this Agency recommends/ suggests the following mitigation measures for the Protection of Environment;

1. All the emissions/ effluents (if any) shall be kept within the permissible limits of the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
2. Solid waste of the project must be collected on daily basis and properly dispose off at the TMA dumping site.
3. Avoid open burning and throwing of solid waste into the surrounding environment/ water bodies.
4. No nuisance by way of noise, dust, odor, soil and ground water contamination shall be caused to the public and surrounding environment during construction and operation of the activity.
5. All electric motors/devices such as pumps, compressor and generator shall be housed in sound proof enclosures to keep safety and noise level within the permissible limits of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).

6. The proponent shall make efforts for water saving, minimizing water consumption and shall practice rain water harvesting and recycle/reuse water to maximum possible extent for secondary purposes (toilet flushes, irrigation of gardens, car washing etc.).
7. Safe treatment and disposal of cooling water, storm water and wash water during cleaning shall be carried out and lubricating oils, greases and cleaning solvents etc. shall be intercepted before the effluents are permitted to flow in public storm water system.
8. The safety and emergency measures shall be carried out, like provisions of Personal Protective Equipments to all the workers during the working hours, installation of fire extinguisher & firefighting system etc.
9. All the steps must be taken to improve the hygienic conditions and good housekeeping of the project area.
10. Septic tanks and soakage pit must be constructed to treat the waste water.
11. Any change/extension in the project shall be communicated to EPA, Regional office, Swat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for further screening and scoping of the project and shall be commenced after obtaining proper approval from this Agency.
12. These mitigation measures do not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force or in future.
13. This Agency reserve the right to inspect and monitor the project site/ Unit any time to check the compliance of the Section 11 and any other provision which is applicable on the project and suggest further measures for the improvement of the environment as per Khyber per Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014.
