OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVAL FOR M/S LUCKY CEMENT LIMITED, PEZU, DISTRICT LAKKI MARWAT KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA FOR NEW LINE-II OF 7700 TPD

Kindly refer to your letter No. LCL/HR&IR/953, dated: 31/03/2023, submitted in response to a meeting held on 08/02/2023 in compliance to the judgment of Environmental Protection Tribunal in case No. 26-P/2021, dated 21/11/2022, it is stated that as per Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, this Agency has been pleased to allow operational activities to "**LUCKY CEMENT LIMITED FOR NEW LINE-II (7700 TPD)**" located at Pezu, District Lakki Marwat subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i. The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures for Environment protection and improvement as mentioned in construction phase environmental approval issued by this Agency vide letter No. EPA/EIA/Cement/Lucky/7700TPD/825, dated 06/11/2017.
- ii. As committed in the above referred letter the management of the factory shall;
 - a. Construct water storage ponds in the national park area.
 - b. Established a Zoo for keeping & breeding of indigenous birds.
 - c. Sign a Memorandum of Understandings (MOU) with the provincial Wildlife Department for implementation of the conditions at S.No.-ii (a) & (b) within a period of three (03) months w.e.f. date of signing of MoU. Copy of the MoU shall be submitted to this Agency.
- iii. Management of the factory shall abide by the decision of the Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as and when taken in the pending matter of conducting mining activities in the leased out forest area.
- iv. Lucky cement factory shall submit a plan to this Agency for rehabilitating the exhausted mining area of Forest land.
- v. All emissions and effluents shall be kept within the permissible limits of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- vi. Stake emissions analysis reports of coal mill, raw mill, cooler and power houses shall be submitted to this Agency on monthly basis from EPA KP certified Laboratory.
- vii. Effluents and ambient air analysis reports shall be submitted to this Agency on quarter basis from EPA KP certified Laboratory.
- viii. Maintenance of the Bag House Filter shall be carried out regularly. Proper record of the same shall be maintained compliance report shall be submitted to this Agency.
- ix. A comprehensive Plantation shall be carried out within and outside the premises of the unit at available spaces. Moreover, seasonal plantation campaign shall be launched with intimation to this Agency.

- x. During the operation, a team of this Agency shall visit the unit for checking the compliance of NEQS on regular basis. No hurdles shall be created for the Agency staff during entry and inspection of the unit.
- xi. EPA may propose further mitigation measures in the light of visit report of this Agency.
- xii. In case of extension/design changes, prior approval from this Agency shall be obtained.
- xiii. For control of dust pollution, regular sprinkling shall be exercised.
- xiv. Coal stock pile shall be properly covered and shall be provided with a sprinkler system.
- xv. Findings of the Ecological study report and Air Dispersion study report submitted to this Agency shall be implemented and compliance report shall be submitted to this Agency.
- xvi. All the vehicles shall be certified from VETS Department.
- xvii. All the social work details shall be displayed at the main gate of the cement factory.
- xviii. Compliance report of the above-mentioned conditions shall be submitted to this Agency on quarterly basis.

Moreover, Schedule-X must be submitted to this Agency within a month time on stamp paper an undertaking for the compliance of terms and conditions as mentioned above, please.
