2. **Description of Project:**

Oil and Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL), is the operator of Wali Exploration License with 100% working interest. It is a large block and seismic studies have identified huge gas and oil reserves in this block. The Wali block reserves are considered to be equal or more than the reserves found in the Nashpa field. According to estimates, upon development of the Wali block with at least nine to ten wells, production of about 100-150 mmcf/d gas is expected. OGDCL made gas discovery in the Wali block near Lakki Marwat in KPK at Wali X-01 well. Wali X-01 was spudded in on December 2, 2019 as an exploratory well and was drilled down to the total depth of 4727 meters into Kawagrah formation.

In view of the above, OGDCL has planned for appraisal wells and development of wali field early production facility (EPF) in Lakki Marwat near Wali X-01 to process the raw gas for CO2 removal. SNGPL will layout pipelines of 55 kilometers to get the gas from the lockhart and supply it to the national grid.

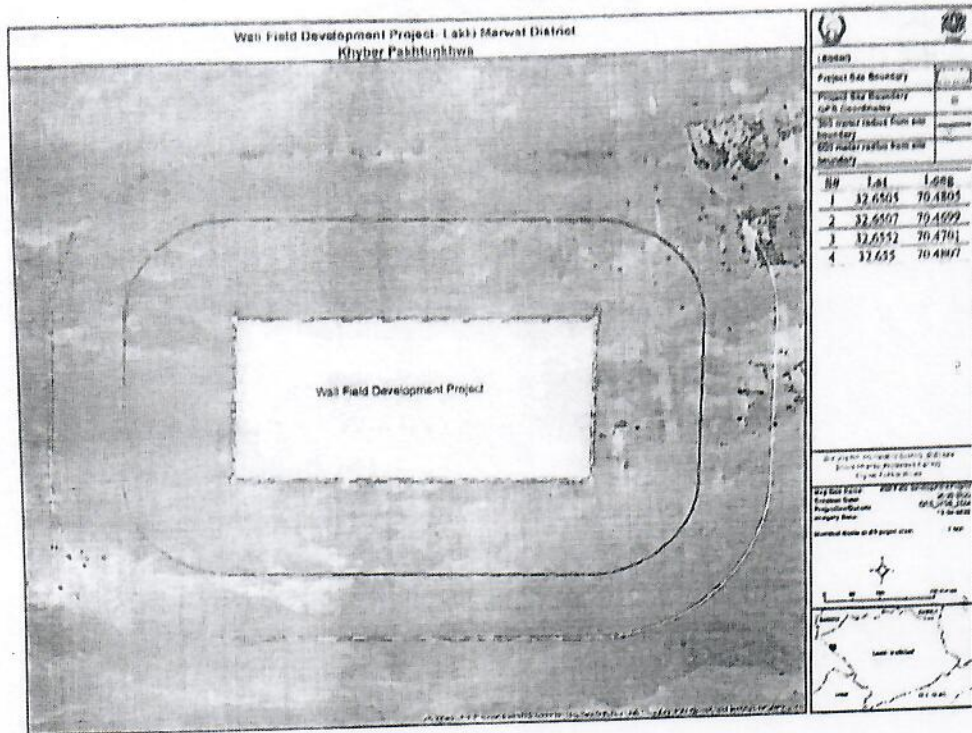




5. **Date of filing of EIA.** 31/10/2022 Ref. (EPA Diary No. 01)
6. After careful review of the EIA and all the comments thereon, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment of **“WALI FIELD DEVELOPMENT PROJECT”** located in Gazboba Village, Bettani District Lakki Marwat under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, subject to the following terms & conditions: -
- i) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operational phase of the project.
  - ii) Land acquisition and compensation issues shall be settled before commencement of construction activities. The proponent must provide copy of agreement between OGDCL Pakistan and the local people of the area regarding land acquisition / crop compensation along-with their complete addresses to this Agency.
  - iii) All the emissions and effluents generated at the facility shall be kept within the NEQS permissible limits. Analysis reports of the same shall be submitted to this Agency on quarter basis from EPA KP certified Laboratory.
  - iv) Ambient Air, Ground water and noise analysis reports within 500m radius of the facility shall be submitted to this Agency on quarter basis.
  - v) Solid waste generated at the unit shall be properly disposed off in coordination with the municipal services provider.
  - vi) The entire vehicle to be used under the project shall be properly tuned. A certificate in this regard shall be obtained from Vehicular Testing Station (VETS) and shall be submitted to this Agency biannually.

- vii) Non technical jobs shall be provided to locals. Besides, preference shall also be given to the locals in technical / skilled jobs subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criteria. Details of the same shall be shared with this Agency.
  - viii) Maximum number of paid internships / apprenticeships shall be arranged on annual basis for technical graduates belong to surround villages. Details of the same shall be shared with this Agency.
  - ix) A proper CSR document, keeping in view quantum of the project activities and demands of the locals shall be finalized, specifically for the proposed line having year to year project wise activities detail. The activities may include but not limited to provision of new water supply scheme, school construction, scholarship, dispensary etc. for the locals. Details of the same shall be shared with this Agency.
  - x) Plantation shall be done as per submitted plantation plan. Besides, seasonal plantation campaign shall be launched in the area with intimation and invitation to this Agency.
  - xi) The existing road shall not be disturbed, in case of any damage; the management of OGDCL shall be responsible for its rehabilitation and maintenance.
  - xii) For the reduction of movement generated pollution regular water sprinkling should be carried out on the unmetalled roads.
  - xiii) Area should be restored in the original form after the completion of project activities.
  - xiv) Measures should be adopted for oil/chemical spill and flammable waste etc.
  - xv) Health safety measure (mask, fire proof jackets, glasses, gloves, shoes, air plugs, helmet etc) should be provided to the workers. Moreover, health reports of the workers shall be submitted to this Agency biannually.
  - xvi) The proponent shall install water meters at all water extraction sources for sustainable use of water.
  - xvii) Natural drainage pattern of the area shall not be disturbed / blocked. Moreover, the proponent shall conduct hydrological study and submit the report to this Agency before applying for operational phase approval.
  - xviii) Water conservation techniques shall be utilized for sustainable water use and detail plan shall be submitted to this Agency before operational activities.
  - xix) Record of all emergencies and accidents shall be maintained on the site.
  - xx) Fire extinguishers, first aid box etc shall be installed inside the premises of the facility in case of any emergency.
  - xxi) Signboards shall be installed on appropriate strategic points.
  - xxii) The proponent will obtain separate approval for pipeline installation from the Agency.
  - xxiii) This Agency reserves the right to suggest any additional measures in case of any environment related issues if observed in/around the unit during regular monitoring.
7. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
  8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rule 14, 15, 18, 19, & 20 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
  9. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. Separate Approval shall be obtained for operational phase of the project as per provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021.
  10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.

11. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
12. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
13. There shall be no legal case pending in any court against the project.
