

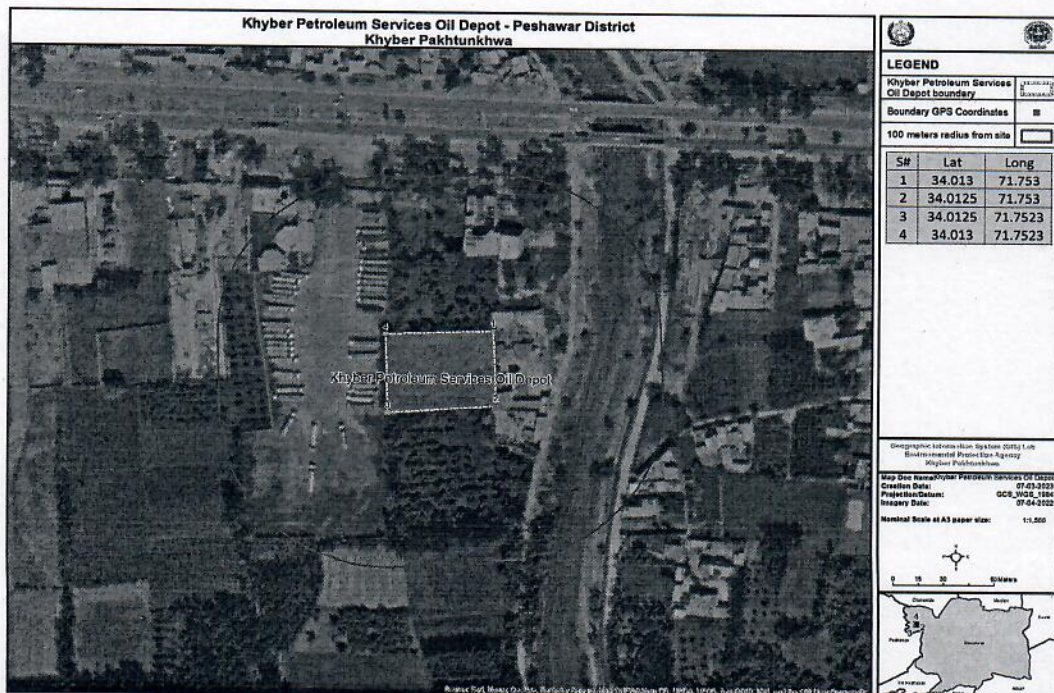

Decision on IEE

1. **Name, Address of proponent:** Muhammad Ikram Khan
Near Durrani Oil Tanker Parking,
Aurangabad, Main GT Road, Taru
Jabba, Nowshera.
2. **Description of project.** The project cost has been estimated about 25 million rupees. The total area of the project is 3 kannal in which the covered area is 0.5 kannal. In the proposed oil depot, 04 petroleum products, i-e kerosene oil, light diesel oil, mineral turpentine tar and solvent oil will be brought, stored and distributed. For this purpose 5 underground tanks having size of 10* 24' and capacity of 50,000 liter each will be made, among which one tank will be spare and will be used during emergency. The source of energy for the proposed project is WAPDA and the number of labor during constructional activities will be 10-15 while during operational stage the number will be 5-6. The Project is located in District Nowshera Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the Initial Environmental Examination of **“Khyber Petroleum Services Pvt.Ltd located at Near Durrani Oil Tanker Parking, Aurang Abad, Main GT Road, Taru Jabba, District Nowshera”** as per above mentioned GPS coordinates/GIS Map, according to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in the IEE report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operational phase of the project.
- b) The parking area shall be identified inside the project area and vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area.
- c) Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the locals and shall also be preferred in technical jobs.
- d) Existing Right of Way (RoW) of the locality shall not be disturbed during construction activities.
- e) Personal protective Equipment's shall be provided to the workers to ensure health and safety along with availability of first aid box for emergency medical coverage.
- f) The Oil/Solvent Storage will be constructed by maintaining the maximum possible safest distance by keeping in view the rules and regulation for oil storage/handling facility of OGRA and explosives departments.
- g) The proponent must obtain NOC from the District Administration of the concerned district.
- h) All the construction/installation in the project area must be carried out according to approved master plan of the project.
- i) NOCs required from any department must be obtained as per the relevant law in vogue.
- j) The plantation must be carried out at the project site in available open spaces and as per submitted planation plan.
- k) The proponent must bring its emissions/effluent, if any, in compliance with National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
- l) Sign boards must be installed on the sensitive areas for guidance of the workers as well as visitors.
- m) Proper mitigation measures to be adopted for fire control, including but not limited to fire extinguishers, fire hydrant, fire blankets, fire trolleys and sand buckets at appropriate points.
- n) The proponent must construct an access road of proper dimension to mitigate the traffic congestion as per the submitted plan.
- o) Mitigation measures must be adopted to control leakages during Improper refueling.
- p) Agricultural land, water bodies, roads, right of ways or any other private land shall be protected.
- q) During construction/development phase, water sprinkling shall be carried out on regular basis for the control of dust pollution in the area.
- r) If any issue come up during execution of the project the proponent shall be made bound to address those issue which are unforeseen and not identified in IEE report.


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
- s) The monitoring team of EPA will visit the project site to check the term and condition of the approval and compliance of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014. Furthermore, the management shall facilitate the EPA Monitoring team at the time of monitoring.
- t) There shall be nothing repugnant to any Govt. order or policy on subject.
- u) In case of land issues, the approval may be considered null and void.
6. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rules 14, 15, 18, 19, 20 & 21 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 regarding conditions of approval, confirmation of compliance, validity period of Approval, entry, inspections & monitoring.
8. This approval is accorded only for the construction and development phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the Rules, 15(1) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021.
9. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
10. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
11. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
12. There is no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for construction phase of **Khyber Petroleum Services Pvt.Ltd** with above mentioned terms and conditions.
