

2. **Description of project:** The project site is located in Risalpur  
Industrial Zone, District Nowshera,  
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The total area  
of the proposed project site is 3.52  
kanal. The total cost of the project is  
estimated to be 15 million PKR. The  
power requirement for the industry  
will be up to 200 KVA. The production  
capacity will be 100 Ton/day. The  
water requirement for boiler and  
condensation process will be 30-  
meter cube. A wastewater treatment  
plant will be installed. Two type of  
pollution Control technology will be  
installed for smell control. One direct  
incineration of smell into boiler and  
second condensation of smell  
contents, which wastewater will be  
treated in wastewater treatment plant  
before final.
3. **Location of project.** Plot No. 155 & 156, Phase 5,  
Industrial Zone, Hattar.



After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval on the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report of **"MUSHTARIKA FEED AND PROTEIN INDUSTRY LOCATED AT PLOT 1/C, RISALPUR ECONOMIC ZONE, NOWSHERA"** according to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, and the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 subject to the following terms and conditions: -

- a. The proponent will adopt all precautionary and mitigatory measures identified in EIA report as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the construction and operation phase of project.
- b. The identified parameters like BOD, COD, H<sub>2</sub>S and NH<sub>3</sub> etc. will be analyzed during operational phase of the project from EPA KP certified laboratory and regular report submission to EPA shall be ensured.
- c. Poultry waste must be covered during the transportation.
- d. Poultry waste must not be left in open atmosphere.
- e. All leakages from the cookers/machinery must be avoided.
- f. Fumigants must be used inside the hall of the unit where cookers are installed and where the poultry waste is stored.
- g. The proponent must not discharge untreated waste water into the surface water body. All the effluents shall be properly treated through Bio-filters to achieve NEQS compliance before final discharge.
- h. For the air pollution control, the management shall comply stack emissions for NEQS and the proponent shall install scrubbing system.
- i. Condensers and thermal cracking arrangements shall be installed for control of bad smell from the cooking process.

- j. The proponent will be bound to control its emission and effluents not to exceed the permissible limits of National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS).
  - k. Solid waste of the unit shall be properly disposed off in environmentally friendly manner in consultation with management of the Industrial estate. The waste shall not be disposed of or burnt openly.
  - l. Health and safety equipment must be provided to the workers of the unit and shall ensure its practice during working hours.
  - m. Environmental Management Plan (EMP) must be strictly followed.
  - n. Plantation of 10-15 feet size plants of Chinar and Deodar should be carried out inside and outside the boundary wall of the unit. Moreover, seasonal plantation campaign shall be launched with intimation and invitation to this Agency.
  - o. All vehicles, generators and other equipment shall be properly tuned and maintained in good working condition in order to minimize emission of pollutants.
  - p. Water sprinkling shall be carried out where required to reduce the public nuisance caused by the dust emissions.
  - q. Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the locals. Preference shall also be given to the locals in technical jobs subject to the availability of eligible candidates. Details of the same shall be shared with EPA KP.
  - r. Analysis reports of emissions, noise, effluents of the unit from EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa certified laboratory shall be submitted to this Agency on quarter basis.
  - s. Health & Safety sign boards/posters shall be installed in various places within the project area.
  - t. The proponent will install water meters on all the water extraction sources for sustainable use of the resource.
  - u. As committed, CSR activities shall be launched in the area and detail of the same shall be submitted to this Agency.
  - v. Proper funds shall be allocated in the EMP for environmental improvement & awareness. Activities shall be carried out in this regard in coordination with EPA KP.
  - w. The management shall be bound to adopt any additional mitigation measures suggested by EPA from time to time during construction & operation of the project activities.
  - x. The proponent shall submit quarterly compliance report of the above-mentioned conditions to this Agency.
7. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided by the environmental consultant.
  8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rule 14, 15, 16, 18, 19 and 20 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
  9. This approval accorded by the Agency under section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, and shall be valid, for commencement of construction for a period of two years from the date of issuance.



10. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain separate approval for operation phase of the project in accordance with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021.
11. Any change/extension in the approved project design shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
12. This approval shall be treated as null and void, if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with:
13. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
14. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project.
15. In exercise of the power under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of "**MUSHTARIKA FEED AND PROTEIN INDUSTRY LOCATED AT PLOT 1/C, RISALPUR ECONOMIC ZONE, NOWSHERA**" only for the construction phase with above-mentioned terms and conditions.
