2. **Description of project.**

Northern Bottling Limited (NBL) was established in 1994. NBL is located at 16- Industrial Estate Hayatabad, Jamrud Road, Peshawar with total factory area of 9.416 acres with covered area of about 70% and open/uncovered 30% respectively. This the case of establishment of new production line in the existing project area. The said project is located at Plot # 15, 15-A, 15-B, 15-D, 16 and 16-B/1, Hayatabad Industrial Estate, Peshawar. Under power requirements, one connection is 4900 KW and the other is 990 KW. Total land area of the project is 9.16 acres. The water discharge for this project will be 550 cubic meters. Wastewater treatment plant is already installed and have surplus capacity to treat the waste water of the additional line. With the construction of the new line production capacity of the unit will be enhanced to 2456 bpm.

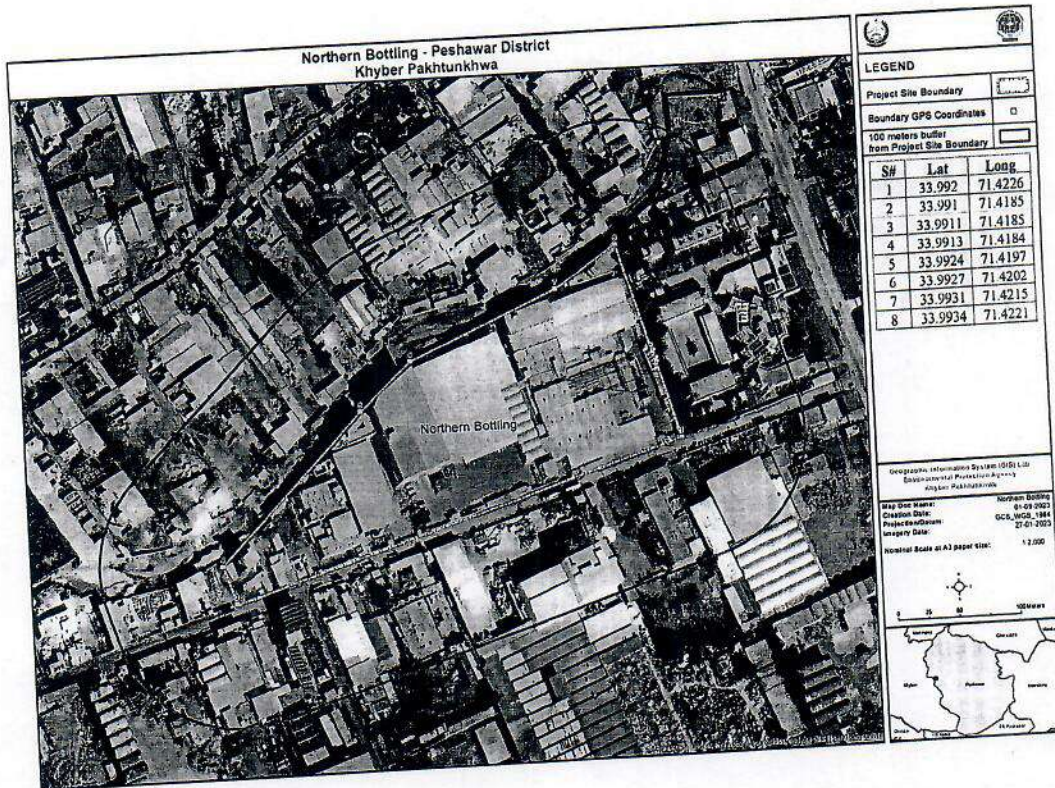



4. **Date of filing of EIA.**
 5. After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord Construction Environmental Approval of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report of “**M/S NORTHERN BOTTLING CO. PVT. LTD.**” in line with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, subject to the following Terms & Conditions;
 - a. The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the EIA Report as well as replies of the proponent submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the Construction and Operation phase of the project.
 - b. Effluents and emissions shall be kept within the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS) permissible limits.
 - c. Additional RO plant shall be installed to reduce the amount of rejected water to half.
 - d. A plan for recollection and recycling of used bottles of the unit shall be shared with this Agency before operation.
 - e. Water meters shall be installed on all water extraction sources.
 - f. The proponent shall carryout seasonal plantation campaigns in consultation with this Agency. Details regarding types and numbers of plantation shall be shared with this Agency well before the plantation season.

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- g. Personnel Protective Equipment (PPEs) must be provided to the workers during the working hours.
 - h. Social/cultural life of the area must be protected and the community must be provided welfare in the form of dispensary, water purification plant etc.
 - i. Access to drinking water for the surrounding should be allowed.
 - j. Non-technical jobs shall be provided to local community/villages. Priority should also be given to locals in technical jobs. Employment record for all positions shall be provided to EPA-Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Internship opportunities shall be provided to the locals regarding acquiring knowledge of technical jobs.
 - k. Labor rates shall be fixed as per market rates and policy of the Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - l. An environmentalist shall be hired for implementation of the Environmental Management plan and other environmental concerns in the project area.
 - m. Proper plan shall be submitted for safe disposal of hazardous waste, if any, before commencement of physical activities. Record of the disposed of hazardous waste material shall be maintained and submitted to this Agency.
 - n. The proponent shall adopt all the possible mitigation measures to prevent ground water contamination at any cost.
 - o. The proponent shall provide the copy of this approval and EIA Report to the contractor for information and compliance. Applicable conditions of this approval shall be made part of the contract agreement. However, compliance of this approval shall be the sole responsibility of the proponent of this project.
 - p. Proper funds shall be allocated for environmental improvement, monitoring facilitation and protection of natural resources of the area in the EMP. Activities shall be carried out in this regard in coordination with EPA KP.
 - q. The proponent shall submit quarterly compliance reports of the above-mentioned conditions including the analysis reports of emissions, effluents and noise from EPA KP certified Laboratory to this Agency.
 - r. This Agency may suggest any additional mitigation measures/updated technology for the control of Environmental Pollution/degradation at any stage (construction & operational phase) of the project;
6. The Proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information supplied by the environmental consultant.
 7. There shall be no legal case pending in any court against the project.




8. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of rules 14, 15, 18, 19, 20 & 21 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
9. This approval accorded by the Agency under section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, and shall be valid, for commencement of construction for a period of two years from the date of issuance.
10. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The Proponent will obtain approval for operation of the project in accordance with the rule-15 and 18 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021.
11. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
12. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with.
13. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
14. The quarterly progress/compliance report of the above conditions shall be submitted to EPA.
15. In exercise of the power under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the EIA Report of "M/S NORTHERN BOTTLING CO. PVT. LTD." for construction phase of the project with above mentioned terms and conditions.
