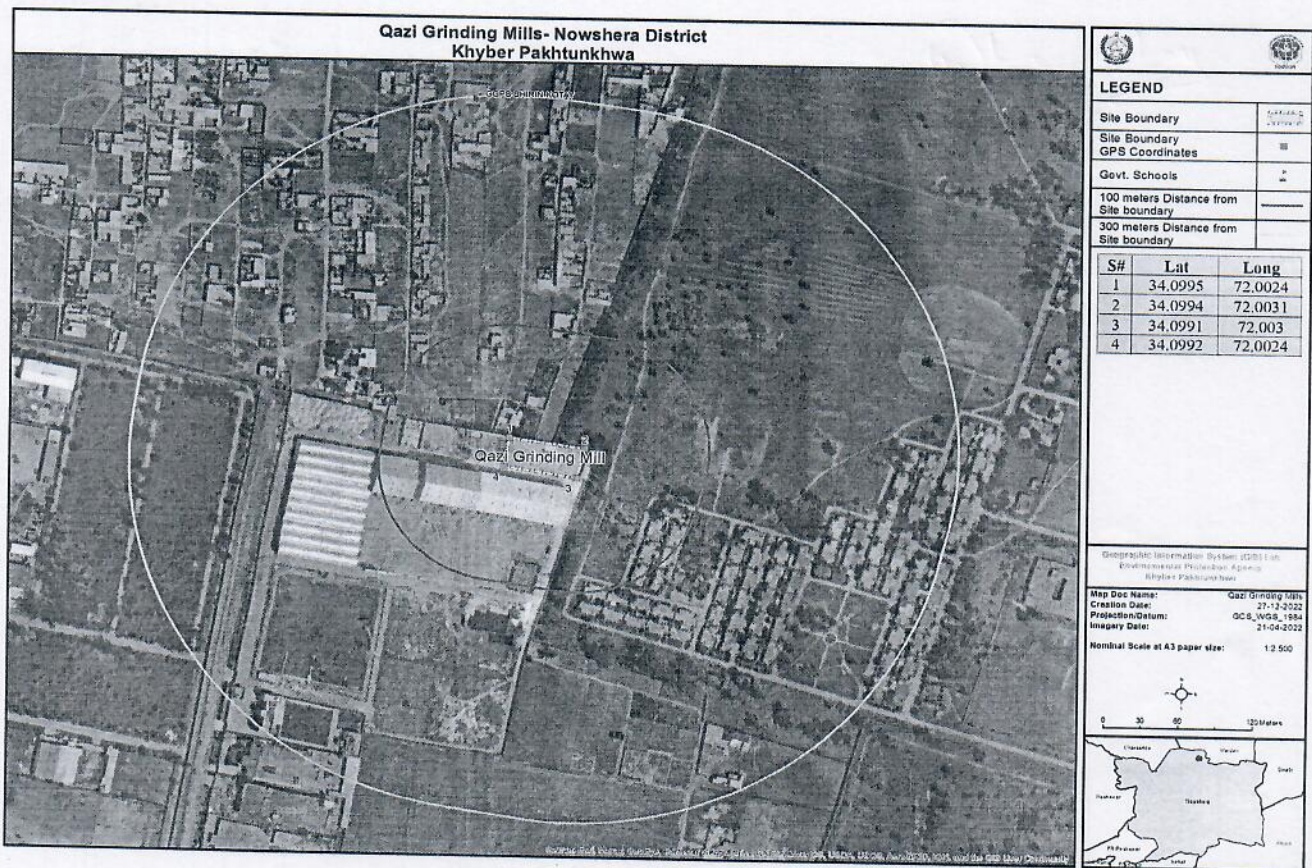
3. **Location of project:**

6. After careful review, the Central Directorate, Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the GEA Report for **“Qazi Grinding Mill, Plot#23, Bara Banda Risalpur Industrial Estate Nowshera”** for **Operational Phase**, in line with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures recommended in the GEA Report submitted to this Agency and any un-anticipated impacts arising during the operation phase of the project.
- b) The proponent shall ensure the compliance and implementation of the National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS) for noise, effluent and gaseous emission during operation phase of the project.
- c) The raw material may not pose any adverse environmental negative impacts on soil. Moreover the raw material and final products shall be placed in designated area.
- d) Adequate number of collection bins for waste shall be provided. Waste from such container/bin shall be collected on daily basis.
- e) Personnel protective equipment's (PPEs) shall be provided to the workers during working hours. Furthermore, the proponent shall also ensure efficient health & safety measures for the protection of workers and passers backed by a comprehensive emergency response plan, e.g. helmets, signboards and shoes etc.
- f) The installed pollution control system shall be properly maintained and operational so as to bring the emission/effluent discharge/noise level within the NEQS Limit. The number of the wall height near the feeding/grinding site shall be further increased to avoid dispersion of dust and noise to the surrounding
- g) The size and number of settling tanks to be increased so as to bring the effluent within NEQS Limit.
- h) First aid box must be available at the project site.
- i) Plantation shall be carried out according to submitted plantation plan.
- j) In case of power shut down, a properly fixe GENSET (if used) shall be installed in a sound/tremor barring and absorbing cabin having at least 10 feet high duct/stack to reduce noise, vibration, smoke and shall comply with the NEQS.
- k) Safety of the social & cultural life of the local community shall be ensured.
 - l) Safety sing boards shall be installed on sensitive area for guidance of workers as well as visitors.
 - m) Spot should be available to carryout laboratory analysis/stack emissions.
 - n) Skilled/unskilled jobs must be offered to the local community first and if not available locally then the same may be hired from other areas.
 - o) The proponent shall submit bi-annual compliance report of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS) for emission, effluent and noise level.
 - p) If any issues come up during execution of the project the proponent shall be made bound to address those issues which are unforeseen and not identified in the submitted GEA Report.
 - q) The monitoring team of EPA will visit the project site to check the terms and conditions of the approval and compliance of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014. Furthermore, the management of the project shall facilitate the EPA monitoring team at the time of monitoring.
 - r) The proponent shall provide the copy of this approval and the GEA Report to the contractor for information and compliance.

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- s) There shall be nothing repugnant to any Govt. order or policy on subject.
t) The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided in the GEA report.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rule 14, 15, 17, 18 and 19 of the Rules, 2021.
 8. This approval is accorded only for three years of the **Operational Phase** of the project. The proponent shall obtain renewal of operational approval after three years.
 10. The proponent shall comply with the rule-14 (2) of the rules, 2021 and shall submit undertaking on stamp paper for compliance of the conditions of approval.
 11. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
 12. This approval shall be treated as Null and Void, if all or any of the conditions mentioned above is/are not complied with:
 13. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force.
 14. There shall be no legal case pending in the courts against the project
 15. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, the undersigned is pleased to approve the GEA Report for operational phase of the aforementioned project with the terms and conditions as mentioned.
