Ltd**" subject to following terms and conditions which needs to be adapted for Environmental Compliance in letter and spirit:

- i. The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures for Environment protection and improvement as mentioned in the Environmental Audit report as referred above.
- ii. All emissions and effluents shall be kept within the permissible limits of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- iii. Technical/Non-technical jobs shall be provided to the local people of the area.
- iv. Hazardous waste shall be incinerated in KP-EPA recognized incinerator, MoU shall be signed and the same must be provided to this Agency.
- v. Seasonal plantation campaign shall be launched with intimation to this Agency.
- vi. Deserving people/ communities shall be preferred for CSR activities.
- vii. Solid waste shall be properly dumped in designated area. The same shall neither be dumped openly nor shall be dumped in any water body.
- viii. Noise, Emissions and effluents analysis reports from EPA KP certified laboratory shall be submitted to this Agency on quarterly basis.
- ix. This Agency shall visit the unit for checking the compliance of NEQS on regular basis. No hurdles shall be created for the Agency staff during entry and inspection of the unit.

- x. EPA may propose further mitigation measures in the light of recommendations of the visiting teams at any stage.
- xi. In case of extension/design changes, prior approval from this Agency shall be obtained.
- xii. Personnel Protective Equipment (PPEs) must be provided to the workers during the working hours.
- xiii. Hydrological study duly verified by Public Health Engineering Department should be submitted annually to this Agency.
- xiv. Water balance report shall be submitted to this Agency, biannually.
- xv. This approval is issued as a stop gap arrangement in the absence of Environmental Audit rules. The proponent shall be bound to comply with the Environmental Audit Rules as and when notified.

Moreover, an undertaking on the attached proforma shall be submitted to this Agency within a month time on stamp paper for the compliance of terms and conditions as mentioned above, please.
