1. **Name, address of proponent:** Mr. Muhammad Ali,
Factory Manager, Pakistan Tobacco
Company, Akora Khattak.

2. **Description of project:** The project for which the Initial
Environmental Examination (IEE)
conducted is "Installation of 2.93 MW On-
Grid Solar Power Plant at Pakistan
Tobacco Company, Akora Khattak
Factory". The project is installed within
the premises of the factory unit on the
available spaces on the roof top of
buildings and parking area in parts.
Pakistan Tobacco Company started
utilizing Solar power energy in 2019 by
installing 25KW solar project, then 50KW
in March 2020, followed by another 50KW
in October, 2020, 1.2 MW in July 2021
and 1.004 MW in 2023. Moreover,
currently the company is about to
complete installation of another 0.6 KW
solar power project. Hence, the total
capacity of the solar power project will be
2.93 MW collectively. The project will
provide sufficient electricity for the day
time production activities inside the unit.
3. **Location of Project:** The project is located at Pakistan Tobacco
Company, Akora Khattak, District
Nowshera.

After careful review, the Environmental Protection Agency, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to accord approval of the **“IEE REPORT OF INSTALLATION OF 2.93 MW ON-GRID SOLAR POWER PLANT AT PAKISTAN TOBACCO COMPANY (PTC), AKORA KHATTAK FACTORY, DISTRICT NOWSHERA”**, according to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) This approval is accorded under Section-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014.
- b) This approval is accorded in light of the decision taken under Agenda item No. 06 in the 2nd Environmental Protection Council (EPC) meeting held dated 11/09/2024 and Administrative Department Notification No. SO(Env)/CCFEWD/4-2/2023/EPC/V-III dated 22/01/2025.
- c) This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or clearance that may be required under any law in force. The proponent shall have to obtain NOCs required from other departments/authorities under the prevailing laws/rules of the provincial government before commencement of the project.
- d) The proponent shall adopt all precautionary and mitigation measures identified in IEE Report, explanation/clarification submitted to this Agency in response to various observations/queries raised during presentation as well as any un-anticipated impacts during the operations of the project.
- e) The Proponent shall ensure the compliance and implementation of the National Environmental Quality Standard (NEQS) for Ambient Air, Noise, Water and Gaseous Emission during construction & operational phase of the Project.
- f) Approval from Power and Energy Department and WAPDA for metering/transmitting activities etc. shall be taken (if required).
- g) The expired/broken solar panels shall be disposed off as per the latest technology/practices available in the market.
- h) The municipal solid waste shall be retained within the unit boundary/premises and disposed of in an environment friendly way at a suitable disposal facility with prior permission of the concerned authority.

- h) The proponent shall construct the Septic tanks for sanitary wastewater and retention pits for the treatment of washing wastewater/effluents.
- j) The proponent shall adopt all mitigation measures for the workers during work at height, installation of solar panels and working with electricity lines.
- k) The proponent shall install lighting arrestor and lighting arrestor for thunderstorms.
- l) The proponent shall construct a retention pit for the treatment of wastewater produced from the cleaning of the solar panels.
- m) Personal protective equipment shall be provided to all workers to ensure health and safety along with first aid box for emergency medical coverage.
- n) Plantation shall be carried out across the boundary of the unit as well at available open spaces inside the unit. Moreover, plantation of 1000 native fast growing, climate friendly, having a height of 05-10 feet shall be carried out.
- o) The monitoring team of this Agency shall regularly visit the Project site to check the terms and conditions of the approval and compliance of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and no hindrance shall be created to the officials of the EPA.
- p) The proponent is bound to implement any additional measures for the protection of Environment as and when suggested by EPA.
7. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rules 14, 15, 18, 19, 20 & 21 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 regarding conditions of approval, confirmation of compliance, validity period of Approval, entry, inspections & monitoring.
8. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of the information provided in the IEE report.
9. This approval is accorded only for the construction/installation and development phase of the project for two (02) years. The proponent shall obtain approval for extension in construction phase or operation of the project in accordance with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021.
10. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.
11. This Agency shall not be responsible for any issue related to the project land.
12. There shall be no legal case pending in any court against the project.
13. In exercise of the power under Section 13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014, **delegated Vide letter No. EPA/050/01/93/2104-2107 dated 16/04/2025** the undersigned is pleased to approve the IEE Report for **"Installation of 2.93 MW On-Grid Solar Power Plant at Pakistan Tobacco Company (PTC), Akora Khattak Factory, District Nowshera"**, for **Construction Phase** of the aforementioned project with the above mentioned terms and conditions.
