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## **A. GENERAL TERMS**

### **1. Introduction**

1.1 Bidders shall adhere to all the requirements of this ITB, including any amendments issued in writing by the Director General, Environmental Protection Agency, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (hereinafter referred to as DG, EPA-KP). This ITB shall be governed under Rule 6(2)(b) **“Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure”** of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Rules, 2014 (as amended from time to time) and instructions of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

1.2 Any bid submitted shall be regarded as an offer by the Bidder and does not constitute or imply the acceptance of the bid by DG, EPA-KP. The Procuring Agency is under no obligation to award a contract to any bidder as a result of this bidding process.

1.3 DG, EPA-KP reserves the right (without any liability) to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, and may cancel the procurement process at any stage by issuing a written notice to all bidders or publishing the cancellation notice on the official websites of EPA-KP and KPPRA.

### **2. Fraud & Corruption, Gifts and Hospitality**

2.1 DG, EPA-KP strictly enforces a policy of zero tolerance towards fraud, corruption, collusion, coercion, unethical or unprofessional practices and requires all bidders/vendors to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and contract implementation.

2.2 Bidders/vendors shall not offer gifts, hospitality, recreational trips, holidays, transportation or invitations to extravagant lunches/dinners to any staff member of EPA-KP.

2.3 In pursuance of this policy, DG, EPA-KP:

(a) Shall reject a bid if it determines that the bidder has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract; and

(b) Shall declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period, to be awarded a contract if it is established that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract awarded by any government or semi-government entity.

### **3. Eligibility**

3.1 A bidder shall not be suspended, debarred or otherwise identified as ineligible by any provincial/federal government entity or international organization. Bidders are required to disclose to DG, EPA-KP if they are subject to any such sanction.

3.2 It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that its employees, service providers and suppliers meet the eligibility requirements as established by DG, EPA-KP.



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#### **4. General Terms**

4.1 The bidder must be registered with the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) for Income Tax and Sales Tax and with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) and must be on the Active Taxpayers List (ATL) of FBR.

4.2 The bidder must not have been blacklisted or declared ineligible by any Government, Semi-Government or Autonomous Body in Pakistan.

4.3 There must be no pending litigation against the bidder/firm in any court of law in Pakistan that may affect the execution of this contract.

4.4 An affidavit on stamp paper of appropriate value (duly attested by Oath Commissioner) confirming clauses 4.2 and 4.3 above must be submitted with the technical bid.

#### **B. PREPARATION OF BIDS**

##### **5. General Considerations**

5.1 In preparing the Bid, the Bidder is expected to examine the ITB in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested may result in rejection of the Bid.

5.2 The Bidder shall not be permitted to take advantage of any errors or omissions in the ITB. Should such errors or omissions be discovered, the Bidder must immediately notify the DG, EPA-KP in writing.

##### **6. Cost of Preparation of Bid**

6.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Bid, regardless of whether its Bid is accepted or not. DG, EPA-KP shall in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, irrespective of the conduct or outcome of the procurement process.

##### **7. Language**

7.1 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and DG, EPA-KP, shall be written in English. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the Bidder may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation into English.

##### **8. Documents Comprising the Bid**

8.1 The Bid shall comprise the following documents (all pages of the Bid must be signed, stamped and properly paginated):

a) Returnable Bidding Forms as provided in Section 6 (duly filled in ink or typed – pencil entries will lead to rejection)

b) Documents establishing the eligibility and qualifications of the Bidder



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c) Technical Proposal with detailed compliance to specifications

d) Price Schedule duly filled and signed

e) Bid Security (if required in BDS) in original

f) Any other documents/attachments required under this ITB or BDS

## 9. Documents Establishing the Eligibility and Qualifications

9.1 The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence of its eligibility and qualifications using the relevant Forms provided in Section 6. To award a contract, the qualifications of the Bidder must be documented to the full satisfaction of DG, EPA-KP.

## 10. Technical Bid Format and Content

10.1 The Technical Bid shall be prepared using the Standard Forms and templates provided in Section 6.

10.2 Where samples are required as per Section 5a, they shall be provided free of charge within the time specified by DG, EPA-KP. Samples will be returned only upon written request of the Bidder and at Bidder's expense, unless otherwise stated.

10.3 Where training is required as per Section 5a, the Bidder shall clearly describe the training program (maintenance & operation) and associated costs. Training shall be conducted in English/Urdu as specified in the BDS.

10.4 The Bidder shall confirm availability of spare parts and after-sales service for a minimum period of (3) years from the date of delivery, unless otherwise specified.

## 11. Price Schedule

11.1 The Price Schedule shall be prepared using Form G provided in Section 6. All prices shall be quoted in Pakistani Rupees (PKR) inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, transportation, and installation charges.

11.2 Any item or service described in this ITB but not priced in the Price Schedule shall be deemed to be included in the prices of other items. The total bid price shall be final and binding.

## 12. Bid Security

12.1 The Bidder shall furnish Bid Security in the amount and form specified in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS). The Bid Security shall remain valid for the period mentioned in the BDS (normally 120–180 days from the date of bid opening).

12.2 The original Bid Security (CDR / Pay Order / Bank Guarantee) in favor of **“Director General, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA-KP)”** MUST be submitted in physical/hard copy along with the Technical Bid. A scanned copy of the same shall be uploaded on EPADS.

12.3 If the original Bid Security is not found with the hard copy, or if the amount, validity, or payee name is incorrect or less than required, the bid shall be rejected forthwith.



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12.4 The Bid Security of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within fourteen (14) days after award of contract or expiry of bid validity. The Bid Security of the successful bidder shall be returned upon submission of Performance Security and signing of contract.

12.5 The Bid Security shall be forfeited if the bidder:

- (a) withdraws or modifies its bid during the bid validity period;
- (b) fails to sign the contract within the stipulated time; or
- (c) fails to furnish the required Performance Security within the specified time.

### **13. Currencies**

13.1 All prices shall be quoted in Pakistani Rupees (PKR) only, inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, transportation, and installation charges. Bids quoted in foreign currency or multiple currencies shall be rejected.

### **14. Joint Venture, Consortium or Association is not allowed.**

### **15. Only One Bid**

15.1 The Bidder shall submit only one bid in its own name. Submission of more than one bid by the same bidder (directly or indirectly) shall result in rejection of all such bids.

15.2 Bids submitted by two or more bidders shall be rejected if they are found to have any of the following:

- a) Common controlling partner, director or shareholder;
- b) Receipt of direct or indirect subsidy/financial benefit from the other bidder(s);
- c) Same legal representative or authorized signatory for this tender;
- d) Subcontractor relationship where one bidder is subcontractor in another's bid and also submits a separate bid;
- e) Same key personnel proposed in more than one bid (except subcontractors who may appear in multiple bids).

### **16. Bid Validity Period**

16.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period specified in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS), **120 days** from the date of bid opening. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected as non-responsive.

16.2 During the bid validity period, the bidder shall maintain its quoted prices, proposed personnel, and all terms of the bid without any change.

### **17. Extension of Bid Validity Period**

17.1 In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original bid validity period, DG, EPA-KP may request bidders in writing to extend the validity of their bids.

17.2 Bidders agreeing to the extension shall also extend the validity of their Bid Security accordingly, without any change in the original bid.



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17.3 Bidders have the right to refuse the extension request without forfeiture of their Bid Security. In such case, their bid shall not be considered further.

#### **18. Clarification on ITB**

18.1 Bidders may request clarification on any part of this ITB in writing (email only) to the address given in the BDS not later than the date mentioned in the BDS.

18.2 DG, EPA-KP shall respond in writing (email) and upload the clarification on EPA-KP website ([www.epakp.gov.pk](http://www.epakp.gov.pk)) and EPADS portal. No individual reply will be given.

18.3 Any delay in response shall not oblige DG, EPA-KP to extend the bid submission deadline unless deemed necessary.

#### **19. Amendment of ITB**

19.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, DG, EPA-KP may amend the ITB by issuing an addendum.

19.2 The addendum shall be uploaded on EPA-KP website and EPADS and shall be binding on all bidders.

19.3 If the amendment is substantial, DG, EPA-KP may extend the deadline for submission of bids.

#### **20. Alternative Bids**

20.1 Alternative bids shall not be accepted. Bidders must quote strictly as per the specifications and schedule of requirements given in this tender document.

#### **21. Pre-Bid Conference**

21.1 No pre-bid conference is scheduled for this tender.

#### **C. SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS**

22. Submission of Bids (Through EPADS + Physical Hard Copy – Both Mandatory)

22.1 Bids shall be submitted in TWO modes simultaneously:

- a) Electronically through EPADS portal(<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>) – Mandatory
- b) One original hard copy (properly bound, signed & stamped on each page) – Mandatory

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**22.3 The hard copy envelope must contain two separate sealed envelopes:**

- Envelope-1 → Marked “TECHNICAL PROPOSAL” (containing Forms A–F + all supporting documents)
- Envelope-2 → Marked “FINANCIAL PROPOSAL” (containing Form G – Price Schedule only)

**22.4 Original Bid Security (CDR/Pay Order/Bank Guarantee) For LOT 1 (CDR @ 600,000) , LOT 2 (CDR @ 150,000) and LOT 3 (CDR @ 100,000) in favor of “Director General, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA-KP)”**

MUST be placed in a separate sealed envelope marked “BID SECURITY” and kept inside the Financial Proposal envelope.

A scanned copy of the same shall also be uploaded on EPADS.

22.5 Bids received through only one mode (either only EPADS or only hard copy) shall be rejected.

**23. Deadline for Submission of Bids**

23.1 Complete bids (both electronic + physical) must reach on or before the date and time specified in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS).

EPADS will automatically reject any electronic bid submitted after the deadline.

23.2 Physical bids received after the deadline will not be accepted.

**24. Withdrawal, Substitution & Modification of Bids**

24.1 Withdrawal, substitution or modification is allowed only before the deadline through EPADS. After deadline, no change shall be entertained.

**25. Bid Opening**

25.1 Technical bids will be opened through EPADS on the same day at the time mentioned in the BDS in the presence of bidders’ representatives who choose to attend virtually or physically.

25.2 Financial bids of only technically qualified bidders will be opened on a later date which will be communicated separately.

25.3 In case of public holiday, bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time.

**Consultancy for Marble Slurry Management, Reuse & Regulatory Framework for KPK**

**1. Background**

Uncontrolled marble slurry disposal in KP has caused widespread degradation of water resources, agricultural soils, and aquatic ecosystems, with documented heavy-metal accumulation in river systems such as the Barandu River (Buner). International experience shows that structured environmental audits, cluster-based Common Treatment Facilities (CTFs), and enforceable regulatory frameworks can transform slurry from an environmental liability into an economic resource. EPA KP therefore seeks consultancy services to prepare a technically rigorous, economically viable, and legally enforceable Marble Slurry Management & Utilization Plan for the province.

**2. Objective of the Assignment**

The objective is to develop an evidence-based provincial framework for sustainable marble slurry management, recycling, reuse, and regulatory compliance.

Specifically, the consultancy shall:

- a. Assess slurry generation, handling, transport, and disposal practices across KP;
- b. Benchmark international best practices and technologies for local adaptation.
- c. Propose feasible treatment, recycling, and value-addition options.
- d. Develop regulatory, compliance, monitoring, and enforcement mechanisms.
- e. Prepare a provincial Marble Slurry Management & Utilization Plan with institutional, financial, and policy components.
