SUBJECT: **OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVAL FOR KHAN STEEL
INDUSTRY AND RE-ROLLING MILLS, S.I.E, DARGAI**

Kindly, refer to your applications No. Nil, dated 15/10/2025 for grant of operational approval, and monitoring report dated 24/02/2026 by officer of this agency, it is stated that the Conditions of Construction Environmental Approval issued via this office tracking No. EPA/ ROS/IEE/Khan Steel Re-Rolling Mill /Malakand/3481-83, dated 28/09/2022, has been implemented. However, plantation has not been carried out to the extent required which may be done according to the plantation plan submitted in IEE Report.

Therefore, the EPA, Malakand Directorate, Swat is pleased to accord the Operational Environmental Approval for the Khan Steel industry and Re-Rolling Mills, located at Plot # 14, small Industrial Estate, Dargai, District Malakand, located at GPS Coordinates N: 34.510516°, E: 71.917348°, according to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Act, 2014 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Assessment Rules, 2021 with the following terms and conditions:

1. The mitigation measures and business plan mentioned in the Constructional Environmental Approval and IEE Report shall be implemented and maintained at all the time.
2. All the emissions/effluents (if any) shall be kept within permissible limits of National Environmental Quality standards (NEQS). The proponent shall construct settling sedimentation tanks for the effluents from the scrubbers constructed inside the unit if in case discharge take place.
3. Any new updated technology in the future proposed by EPA shall be implemented for the protection of Environment.
4. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Rules 19 and 20 of Environmental Assessment Rules 2021 regarding entry, inspection and monitoring. In this regard a biannual (06 months) report summarizing operational performance of the project with reference to the conditions of approval and maintenance and mitigation measures adopted by the project shall be submitted by proponent to this Agency.
5. The proponent shall apply for renewal of the operational approval after every three (03) years as per rule 15(4) of Environmental Assessment Rules 2021.
